

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
SUNDAY, APRIL 30, 2006 0800 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 2

CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack activity was light nationally with 47 new fires reported. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Arizona, New Mexico, Michigan, Minnesota, Vermont, and Wisconsin.

SOUTHERN AREA INCIDENTS/LARGE FIRES:

WEST TEXAS IA, Texas Forest Service. A Texas State Type 2 Team (Rogers) is assigned in Midland, TX. The Team is assisting local jurisdictions with managing initial and extended attack fires within the 140 million acre fire management response area. No new fires were reported within the management area. Acres, structure losses and costs represent cumulative fire activity for the response area.

SIX PACK, Big Cypress National Preserve. A Type 1 Incident Management Team (Custer) is assigned. This fire is 20 miles northeast of Ochopee, FL in southern rough. Backing and flanking fire behavior was reported. Good progress was made in burn out operations.

ACERA, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is six miles northwest of Sharpes, FL in southern rough. No new information was reported.

CORBETT TRAIL, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is four miles south of Indiantown, FL in grass. No new information was reported.

GARCON-EASTER, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is five miles south of Bagdad, FL in grass. No new information was reported.

FL SPORTS PARK, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is near Naples, FL in southern rough. No new information was reported.
