Predictive Services Discussion: Hot and dry weather will continue across most of the West today. Gusty winds and low humidity are expected over western and northern Nevada as well as some locations in the southern California mountains. Thunderstorms, some of them dry, are expected over portions of Wyoming, Colorado and western New Mexico. In Alaska, rain is expected in south central portions with some thunderstorms in the interior. The Southeast will see scattered thundershowers.

ESCAPE ROUTES

An escape route is a preplanned and understood route to reach a safety zone.

- What are the primary concerns in choosing an escape route?
 - - Select the closest, least obstructed route.
 - Plan for more than one escape route.
 - Avoid an uphill escape.
 - Scout and clearly mark the route for visibility (aids during smoky situations or night operational periods).
- - Determine escape time--consider slowest person, fatigue, and temperature factors.
 - Continuously reassess the situation with regard to work progress and additional resource arrivals.
 - Assure all line personnel are familiar with escape routes.
