Linville Complex (three fires), National Forests in North Carolina. IMT 1 (Quesinberry). Twelve miles northeast of Marion, NC. Logging slash. Short runs and backing fire. Residences threatened. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Big Turnaround Complex, Okefenokee NWR. Transfer of command from IMT 1 (Ruggiero) to FUMT (Perkins) today. Ten miles southeast of Waycross, GA. Southern rough and timber. Minimal fire activity.

Sweat Farm Road, Georgia Forestry Commission. Georgia IMT 2 (Floyd). Started on private land 10 miles west of Waycross, GA. Southern rough and timber. Creeping and smoldering.

Okeechobee Complex (ten fires), Florida DOF. Eight miles southwest of Okeechobee, FL. Grass, Southern Rough. No further information received.
