Su River, Mat-Su Area Forestry. Twenty-seven miles southwest of Talkeetna, AK. Black spruce and mixed hardwoods. Crown fire, running and spotting. Residences and cabins threatened. Evacuation of Trapper Lake area in effect.

Paldo, Fairbanks Area Forestry, Alaska DOF. One hundred miles east of Fairbanks, AK. Timber and understory. Creeping and isolated torching. Last narrative report unless significant activity occurs.
