Sweat Farm Road, Georgia Forestry Commission. IMT 2 (Hannemann), (Floyd). NIMO (Ferguson). IMT 2 transition. Started on private land 10 miles west of Waycross, GA. Southern rough and timber. Extreme fire behavior. U.S. Highway 1 remains closed.

Big Turnaround Complex, Okefenokee NWR. IMT 1 (Ruggiero). IMT also managing the Bugaboo Scrub fire. Ten miles southeast of Waycross, GA. Southern rough and timber. Running and short-range spotting. Private timber plantations threatened.

Bugaboo Scrub, Okefenokee NWR. Sixteen miles west of Folkston, GA. Southern rough and chaparral. Running and short-range spotting. Private timber plantations threatened.

Round About Swamp, Georgia Forestry Commission. Started on private land four miles west of Pearson, GA. Southern rough and timber. Extreme fire behavior. No further information received.

Knee Knocker Swamp, Georgia Forestry Commission. One mile northwest of Nahunta, GA. Southern rough and logging slash. No further information received.

Airport Road, Florida DOF. IMT 2 (Utley). IMT also managing the Red Oak fire. Three miles southwest of Ormond Beach, FL. Hardwood litter. No further information received.

Dairy Road, Florida DOF. Sixteen miles northeast of Gainesville, FL. Timber. No further information received.

Pinnacle, National Forests in North Carolina. Fifteen miles east of North Cove, NC. Hardwood litter and timber. Smoldering and creeping fire. No further information received.

Balsa, Florida DOF. Ten miles east of East Naples, FL. No further information received.

Black Creek, Florida DOF. Three miles south of Bruce, FL. No further information received.

Cherokee Road, Florida DOF. Four miles southeast of Gateway, FL. Chaparral. No new information.
