Transfer of command from Area Command Team (Loach) to Area Command Team (Ribar) will occur today. The Area Command Team is assigned to manage large fires for the Boise and Payette National Forests.

Grays Creek, Payette NF. IMT 2 (Harvey). Thirteen miles south of Council, ID. Timber and grass. Active surface fire with short crown runs. Structures threatened. Area closures and evacuations in effect.

Chief Parrish, Southwest Area Office, Idaho Department of Lands. IMT 2 (Saleen). One mile south of Banks, ID. Timber, brush and grass. Isolated torching and short crown runs. Community of Banks threatened. Highway 55 and area closures in effect.

Sweetwater, Idaho Falls District, BLM. Six miles west of Cokeville, WY. Brush and grass. Creeping and smoldering. Community of Cokeville and power transmission lines threatened. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Rose Creek, Boise District, BLM. Thirty-one miles south of Murphy, ID. Juniper, sage brush and grass. Isolated torching and smoldering.

Middle Mountain, Twin Falls District, BLM. Five miles south of Oakley, ID. Brush. Smoldering and creeping. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Cascade Complex, Boise NF. Transfer of command from IMT 1 (Muir) to IMT 2 (Whalen) today. Twenty-seven miles east of Cascade, ID. Timber. Creeping and smoldering with limited torching. Structures, power lines, cultural sites and historical cabins are threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

East Zone Complex (3 fires), Payette NF. Transfer of command from NIMO (Ferguson) to IMT 1 (Broyles) yesterday. IMT will also manage the Donnelly Zone of the Grays Creek fire. Twenty-five miles northeast of McCall, ID. Timber, brush and grass. Active fire behavior with surface runs and group tree torching. Communities of Secesh, South Fork and Warren threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

Confluence Complex (3 fires), Salmon-Challis NF. IMT 2 (Lund). Twenty eight miles southwest of North Fork, ID. Mixed conifer, brush, grass and heavy dead and down fuels. Active fire behavior. Structures, historic and cultural sites threatened.

Shower Bath Complex (2 fires), Salmon-Challis NF. Eighteen miles northwest of Challis, ID. Timber with heavy dead and down fuels. Creeping and smoldering with occasional group tree torching. Structures, historic cabins and cultural sites threatened. Scattered light precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Krassel Complex (6 fires), Payette NF. FUMT (Hahnenberg). Forty-four miles northeast of Yellow Pine, ID. Timber, grass and heavy dead and down fuels. Active fire with torching and crowning. Structures threatened.

Turnbull, Twin Falls District, BLM. Ten miles southwest of Burley, ID. Brush and grass. Wind-driven fire activity. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Harper, Richfield Field Office, BLM. Fourteen miles southwest of Nephi, UT. Pinyon juniper, sage brush and grass. Active surface fire with torching and spotting.

Sawmill Complex (4 fires), Lolo NF. IMT 2 (Angell). Twenty-two miles southeast of Missoula, MT. Timber and grass. Active surface fire with group tree torching. Structures threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

Rattlesnake, Nez Perce NF. IMT 2 (Grant). Twenty-five miles south of Elk City, ID. Timber and grass. Minimal fire activity.

Ahorn, Lewis and Clark NF. IMT 2 (Kusicko). IMT also managing the Fool Creek fire. Thirty miles west of Augusta, MT. Timber. Active fire behavior with running ground fire, group torching and short sustained crown runs. Structures threatened. Evacuations and area closures in effect.

Fool Creek, Lewis and Clark NF. Thirty miles northwest of Choteau, MT. Timber and snags. Active surface fire with group tree torching.

Rombo Mountain, Bitterroot NF. IMT 2 (McNitt). Eighteen miles south of Darby, MT. Bug-killed timber. Moderate fire activity with occasional torching and short uphill crown runs. Structures threatened. Scattered precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Rat Creek, Beaverhead/Deerlodge NF. Twenty-five miles west of Wisdom, MT. Timber. Surface fire with group tree torching. Scattered precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Pattengail Creek, Beaverhead/Deerlodge NF. Ten miles northeast of Wisdom, MT. Timber with dead and down fuels. Backing fire with isolated torching. Scattered precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Jocko Lakes, Flathead Agency, BIA. Transfer of command from IMT 1 (Hoff) back to local unit today. Twenty-six miles northeast of Missoula, MT. Timber with dead and down lodgepole pine. Minimal fire activity.

Bridge (2 fires), Clearwater NF. Forty-five miles southwest of Missoula, MT. Timber and brush. Creeping, smoldering fire with single tree torching and short-range spotting.

Conger Creek, Lolo NF. Twenty miles north of Ovando, MT. Timber. Short wind-driven runs with group tree torching and spotting.

Lighthouse, Eastern Land Office, Montana DNR. Nine miles north of Miles City, MT. Grass. No further information received.

Forest Grove, Lolo NF. Ten miles southeast of Superior, MT. Ponderosa pine and grass. Creeping surface fire. Residences and power lines threatened. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

BH, Bitterroot NF. Thirty-six miles southwest of Darby, MT. Timber. Active surface fire with single tree torching. Intermittent closure of Magruder Road in effect.

WH Complex (2 fires), Gallatin NF. Twenty-seven miles south of Livingston, MT. Timber. Backing fire with group tree torching.

Corporal, Flathead NF. Forty-seven miles southeast of Kalispell, MT. Timber. Active fire with group tree torching and short crown runs.

Bitterroot Fire Use Complex (14 fires), Bitterroot NF. Fifteen miles west of Darby, MT. Timber and grass. Active surface fire with occasional torching. Intermittent road closures in effect.
