**Cascade Complex**, Boise NF. IMT 2 (Whalen). Twenty-seven miles east of Cascade, ID. Timber. Active fire behavior with creeping and torching. Structures, power lines, cultural sites and historical cabins are threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

**East Zone Complex** (4 fires), Payette NF. IMT 1 (Broyles). IMT also managing Donnelly zone of the Grays Creek fire and the Big Creek portion of the Krassel Complex WFU. Twenty-five miles northeast of McCall, ID. Timber. Isolated torching and short uphill runs. Structures threatened. Road closures and evacuations in effect.

**Krassel Complex** (4 fires), Payette NF. Forty-four miles northeast of Yellow Pine, ID. Timber, grass and heavy dead and down fuels. Active fire behavior. Structures threatened. Last narrative report unless significant occurs.

**Rat Creek**, Beaverhead/Deerlodge NF. Twenty-five miles west of Wisdom, MT. Timber. Active fire behavior.

**Pattengail Creek**, Beaverhead/Deerlodge NF. Ten miles northeast of Wisdom, MT. Timber with dead and down fuels. Creeping.
