Middle Fork Complex (52 fires), Willamette NF. Washington IMT 2 (Gormley). Lane County, OR. Timber, brush and slash. Moderate fire behavior with creeping and smoldering.

North Fork Complex (8 fires), Umpqua NF. IMT 2 (Batten). Twenty-six miles northeast of Glide, OR. Timber. Backing fire with short uphill runs. Structures threatened.

Wild Rivers Complex (3 fires), Siskiyou NF. IMT 2 (Suwyn). Seventeen miles southwest of Grants Pass, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching.

Summit Springs Complex, Sisters Unit, Oregon DOF. Nine miles north of Sisters, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior.

Ochoco Fire Use – WFU, Ochoco NF. Ten miles southwest of Dayville, OR. Timber. No new information.

Jack Creek, Okanogan/Wenatchee NF. Transfer of command from FUMT (Bonefeld) back to local unit occurred yesterday. Confine/contain management strategy. Thirteen miles southwest of Leavenworth, WA. Subalpine fir. Smoldering. Precipitation occurred over the fire. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Lonesome Complex (3 fires), Rogue River NF. Twenty-one miles northeast of Prospect, OR. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering.

Clackamas River Complex (30 fires), Mt. Hood NF. Twenty-six miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Timber. No new information. Last report unless new information received.
