Rocky, Lincoln NF. IMT 2 (Cowie). Thirty-five miles west of Carlsbad, NM. Pinyon pine, juniper and grass. Extreme fire activity. Structures and gas wells threatened.

West Fork, Cimarron District, New Mexico State Forestry. IMT 2 (Reinarz). Twenty-eight miles west of Raton, NM. Mixed conifer and juniper with oak understory. Active surface fire with group tree torching. Natural gas pipeline threatened.

Bonnie, Capitan District, New Mexico State Forestry. Thirty-three miles west of Roswell, NM. Extreme fire behavior. No further information received.

Wild Bull, Cibola NF. Confine/contain management strategy. Thirty miles north of Truth or Consequences, NM. Pinyon pine, juniper and grass. Moderate fire behavior. Monitor status. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Evans Road, North Carolina Division of Forest Resources. IMT 2 (Hendricks) and NIMO (Whitney). Seven miles south of Creswell, NC. Pocosin, chaparral, and southern rough. Single tree torching, spotting and smoldering in deep organic soils. Residences threatened.

South 1, Great Dismal Swamp NWR. IMT 2 (Wilder). Twelve miles southeast of Suffolk, VA. Logging slash and blow down. Active ground fire with slow rates of spread and smoldering.

Holmes, Texas Forest Service. IMT 2 (Hannemann). IMT is also managing the Tubbs Corner, Sutton Ranch, Juniper Peak, Agua Si and Devin Loop fires. Started on private land seventeen miles north of Bracketteville, TX. Juniper, brush and grass. Extreme fire behavior. Numerous residences threatened.

Tubbs Corner, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land twelve miles northwest of Crane, TX. Juniper, brush and grass. Minimal fire activity.

Windmill Road, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land twenty-five miles southeast of Ozona, TX. Grass. Moderate fire activity.

Sutton Ranch, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land twenty-three miles southwest of Ozona, TX. Brush, pinyon pine, juniper and grass. Moderate fire activity.

Juniper Peak, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land twenty-one miles north of San Angelo, TX. Brush, pinyon pine, juniper and grass. Moderate rates of spread. Residences threatened.

Agua Si, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land twenty-nine miles west of Ozona, TX. Brush, pinyon pine, juniper and grass. Smoldering.

Devin Loop, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land twelve miles northwest of Crane, TX. Brush, pinyon pine, juniper and grass. Moderate fire activity. Structures threatened.
