Area Command Team (Zimmerman). NIMO (Gage) assigned to Shasta-Trinity NF.

**Walker**, Sonoma-Lake Napa Unit, Cal Fire. Ten miles northeast of Clearlake Oaks, CA. Chaparral. Rapid rates of spread with long-range spotting. Residences threatened.

**Wild**, Sonoma-Lake Napa Unit, Cal Fire. Cal Fire IMT 1 (Morris). Five miles east of Napa, CA. Brush. Spotting. Residences threatened. Evacuations in effect.

**BTU Lightning Complex** (17 fires), Butte Unit, Cal Fire. Butte County, CA. Timber, brush and grass. Active fire behavior with short-range spotting. Communities of Concow and Magalia threatened. Evacuations in effect.

**SHU Lightning Complex** (153 fires), Shasta-Trinity Unit, Cal Fire. Cal Fire IMT 1 (Kerschen). Shasta and Trinity counties, CA. Timber, brush and grass. Active fire behavior. Residences, commercial property and power transmission lines threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

**Iron Complex** (27 fires), Shasta-Trinity NF. IMT 2 (Swartzlander). Previously reported as the SHF June Lightning Complex. One mile north of Junction City, CA. Heavy timber, brush and grass. Moderate rates of spread with uphill runs and occasional torching. Residences threatened.

**Lime Complex** (50 fires), Shasta-Trinity NF. Transfer of command from IMT 2 (Kaage) to IMT 1 (Opliger) today. Complex includes previously reported fires from the SHF June Lightning Complex. Fourteen miles west of Hayfork, CA. Timber. Active fire behavior with single and group tree torching, short duration crown runs, short-range spotting and flanking. Numerous residences and structures threatened. Evacuations in effect.

**Whiskeytown Complex** (6 fires), Whiskeytown National Recreation Area, NPS. Twelve miles west of Redding, CA. Timber and brush. Moderate fire activity with spotting. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Road closures in effect.

**Canyon Complex** (45 fires), Plumas NF. IMT 1 (Pincha-Tulley). Sixteen miles northeast of Paradise, CA. Timber. Surface fire with backing, uphill runs, torching and crowning. Residences threatened. Road closures in effect.

**Yuba River Complex** (28 fires), Tahoe NF. IMT 1 (Summerfelt) and IMT 2 (Joseph). Thirteen miles northeast of Nevada City, CA. Timber and brush. Moderate to rapid rates of spread and backing fire activity. Residences and power lines threatened. Road closures in effect.

**American River Complex** (3 fires), Tahoe NF. Eleven miles northeast of Foresthill, CA. Timber, brush and chaparral. Moderate to rapid rates of spread.

**Mendocino Lightning Complex** (131 fires), Mendocino Unit, Cal Fire. Cal Fire IMT 1 (Waterman). Mendocino County, CA. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with group tree torching. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations in effect.

**June ABCD Misc Complex** (52 fires), Mendocino NF. Twenty-four miles southwest of Chico, CA. Chaparral, timber and grass. Backing fire with short runs and torching. Residences threatened.

**Hell's Half Complex** (2 fires), Six Rivers NF. IMT 2 (Lund). Eight miles southwest of Burnt Ranch, CA. Timber. High rates of spread. Structures threatened.

**Humboldt Complex** (2 fires), Humboldt-Del Norte Unit, Cal Fire. Humboldt County, CA. Timber, slash and grass. Slow rates of spread. Numerous residences threatened.

**Mad Complex** (11 fires), Six Rivers NF. Humboldt County, CA. Timber, brush and grass. Low to moderate fire activity.

**Orleans/Ukonom Complex** (9 fires), Six Rivers NF. IMT 2 ordered. Three miles southwest of Somes Bar, CA. Timber. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs. Structures threatened.

**SRF Lightning Complex** (8 fires), Six Rivers NF. Fifteen miles northeast of Willow Creek, CA. Timber. No new information.

**Peterson**, Lassen NF. IMT 2 ordered. Ten miles east of Cassell, CA. Timber and grass. Communities of Little Valley and Pitville threatened. Evacuations in effect. No further information received.

**Cub Complex** (2 fires), Lassen NF. Sixteen miles southwest of Chester, CA. Timber. Smoke impacting communities. No further information received.

**Popcorn**, Lassen-Modoc Unit, Cal Fire. Previously reported under the LMU June Lightning Complex. Nine miles northwest of Little Valley, CA. Timber, brush and grass. Rapid rates of spread with long-range spotting. Communities of Little Valley and Pittville threatened. Evacuations in effect.

**LNF June Lightning Complex**, Lassen NF. Sixteen miles southwest of Chester, CA. Timber. Smoke impacting area communities. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping. No further information received.

**Siskiyou Complex** (4 fires), Klamath NF. IMT 2 (Paul). Eighteen miles southwest of Happy Camp, CA. Conifer and hardwood overstory with heavy timber litter. Active backing fire with uphill runs and spotting. Historical and cultural resources threatened.

**TGU Lightning Complex** (7 fires), Tehama-Glenn Unit, Cal Fire. Tehama County, CA. Chaparral. Moderate rates of spread.

**Quarry**, San Mateo-Santa Cruz Unit, Cal Fire. One mile west of Brisbane, CA. Grass and brush. Minimal fire activity.

**Whitehurst**, Santa Clara Unit, Cal Fire. Four miles west of Gilroy, CA. Timber. Minimal fire activity.

**Blue**, Six Rivers NF. Twelve miles northeast of Klamath, CA. Heavy timber and brush. No further information received.

**Rocky**, Lincoln NF. IMT 2 (Cowie). Thirty-five miles west of Carlsbad, NM. Pinyon pine, juniper and grass. Moderate surface fire activity with isolated torching. Structures threatened.

**West Fork**, Cimarron District, New Mexico State Forestry. IMT 2 (Reinarz). Twenty-eight miles west of Raton, NM. Mixed conifer and juniper with oak understory. Smoldering and creeping.

**Bonney**, Capitan District, New Mexico State Forestry. Thirty-one miles west of Roswell, NM. Pinyon pine, juniper and grass. Minimal fire activity. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Evans Road**, North Carolina Division of Forest Resources. North Carolina IMT 2 (Brandon) and NIMO (Whitney). Seven miles south of Creswell, NC. Pocosin, chaparral, and southern rough. Creeping and smoldering in deep organic soils. Residences threatened. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**South 1**, Great Dismal Swamp NWR. IMT 2 (Wilder). Twelve miles southeast of Suffolk, VA. Logging slash and blow down. Creeping fire.

**Sutton Ranch**, Texas Forest Service. IMT 2 (Hannemann). IMT is also managing the Dry Devil's River, Deaton and Tucker Ranch fires. Started on private land twenty-three miles southwest of Ozona, TX. Brush, pinyon pine, juniper, slash and grass. Minimal fire activity. Monitor status. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

**Smith Marsh 2008**, San Bernard NWR. Seven miles southeast of Cedar Lake, TX. Tall grass. Backing fire.

**Cow Trap 2008**, San Bernard NWR. Seven miles southeast of Cedar Lake, TX. Tall grass. Backing fire.

**Dry Devil's River**, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land thirty miles south of Sonora, TX. Pinyon juniper, brush and grass. Active fire behavior. Oil wells threatened.

**Deaton**, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land thirty-nine miles south of Ozona, TX. Brush, pinyon pine, juniper and grass. Slow rates of spread with spotting.

**Tucker Ranch**, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land ten miles east of Big Lake, TX. Pinyon juniper, brush and grass. Minimal fire activity. Monitor status.

### Operational Briefings

Operational briefings are critical to safe fire operations. To ensure a consistent and effective briefing, a standardized briefing checklist should always be used. The following checklist is printed on the cover of the NWCG Incident Response Pocket Guide:

● Situation:

- Fire name, location, map orientation, other incidents in the area
- Terrain influences
- Fuel type and conditions
- Fire weather (previous, current, and expected)
- Fire behavior (previous, current, and expected)

● Mission/Execution:

- Command (Incident Commander/immediate supervisor)
- Commander's intent
- Specific tactical assignments
- Contingency plans

● Communications:

- Communication Plan (tactical, command, air/ground frequencies, cell phone numbers, etc.)
- Medivac Plan

● Service/Support:

- Other resources that may be working adjacent to you and those available to order
- Aviation operations
- Logistics (e.g., transportation, supplies, equipment)

● Risk Management:

- Identify known hazards and risks
- Identify control measures to eliminate hazards and reduce risk
- Identify trigger points for disengagement or reevaluation of operational plan
