Zimmerman's Area Command Team is providing planning and incident management support to the Shasta-Trinity National Forest. Lohrey's Area Command Team is managing large fire complexes on the Lassen National Forest. Gage's NIMO Team is supporting the ONCC Multi-Agency Coordinating Group.

**BTU Lightning Complex** (31 fires), Butte Unit, Cal Fire. Cal Fire IMT 1 (Lewin). Twenty-seven miles north of Yuba City, CA. Timber, brush and logging slash. Active fire behavior with occasional crown runs and spotting. Communities of Jarbo Gapa and Concow threatened. Precautionary evacuation advisories have been issued for several communities. Highway 70 closed.

**SHU Lightning Complex** (70 fires), Shasta-Trinity Unit, Cal Fire. Cal Fire IMT 1 (Kerschen). Shasta and Trinity counties, CA. Timber, brush and grass. Extreme fire behavior. Junction City, Platina, Corman Ranch and power generation system threatened. Evacuation orders in effect for several communities.

**Whiskeytown Complex** (3 fires), Whiskeytown National Recreation Area, NPS. IMT 2 (McNitt). Twelve miles west of Redding, CA. Timber and brush. Moderate fire activity with backing and upslope runs. Communication towers and power lines threatened.

**Lime Complex** (48 fires), Shasta-Trinity NF. Transfer of command from IMT 2 (Kaage) to IMT 1 (Opliger) occurred. Fourteen miles west of Hayfork, CA. Timber. Short uphill runs with active backing, flanking and spotting. Numerous structures, ranches and youth camps threatened. Communities of Platina and Wildwood evacuated. Hwy 36 closed.

**Iron Complex** (27 fires), Shasta-Trinity NF. IMT 2 (Swartzlander). IMT 1 (Broyles). One mile north of Junction City, CA. Heavy timber, brush and grass. Moderate fire activity. Communities and lookout threatened. Evacuations in effect. Highway 299 has restricted traffic flow. Reduction in acreage due to transfer of five fires to the Alps Complex.

**Alps Complex** (15 fires), Shasta-Trinity NF. FUMT (Soper). Confine/contain management strategy. Three miles northeast of Burnt Ranch, CA. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior. Residences threatened.

**MEU Lightning Complex** (107 fires), Mendocino Unit, Cal Fire. Cal Fire IMT 1 (Waterman). Mendocino County, CA. Timber and grass. Moderate to rapid rates of spread with isolated torching and spotting. Numerous residences threatened. Greenfield and Singley threatened. Evacuations in effect.

**Canyon Complex** (30 fires), Plumas NF. IMT 1 (Pincha-Tulley). Sixteen miles northeast of Paradise, CA. Timber. Moderate rates of spread and isolated torching. Residences and archeological sites threatened. Road closures in effect.

**American River Complex** (3 fires), Tahoe NF. IMT 1 (Summerfelt). Eleven miles northeast of Foresthill, CA. Timber, brush and chaparral. Active surface fire with short uphill runs and single and group tree torching. Watershed, power lines and private inholdings threatened.

**Yuba River Complex** (3 fires), Tahoe NF. IMT 2 (Joseph). Thirteen miles northeast of Nevada City, CA. Timber and brush. Backing fire with uphill runs. Several communities, hydroelectric facilities and recreation sites threatened.

**Peterson Complex**, Lassen NF. Unified command between IMT 1 (Ruggiero) and Cal Fire. Twelve miles east of Cassell, CA. Timber and grass. Creeping, smoldering and spotting. Residences threatened.

**Mill Complex**, Lassen NF. IMT 1 (Larsen). Sixteen miles northeast of Los Molinos, CA. Timber. No further information received.

**Cub Complex** (2 fires), Lassen NF. IMT 2 (Batten). Sixteen miles southwest of Chester, CA. Timber. Active backing fire with short uphill runs, isolated torching and spotting. Smoke impacting community of Chester.

**Corral**, Lassen-Modoc Unit, Cal Fire. Twenty-three miles west of Termo, CA. Timber and grass. Moderate rates of spread with spotting.

**Soda Complex** (4 fires), Mendocino NF. IMT 2 (Heintz). Fifteen miles northwest of Upper Lake, CA. Chaparral, mixed conifer and oak woodlands. Backing fire with group tree torching. Residences threatened.

**June ABCD Misc Complex** (52 fires), Mendocino NF. Twenty-four miles southwest of Chico, CA. Chaparral, timber and grass. Backing fire with short runs and isolated torching. Partially burning in wilderness area.

**Mad Complex** (4 fires), Six Rivers NF. Humboldt County, CA. Timber, brush and grass. Moderate fire activity. Residences threatened.

**Hell's Half Complex** (2 fires), Six Rivers NF. IMT 2 (Secrest). Eight miles southwest of Burnt Ranch, CA. Timber. Moderate fire activity with occasional torching. Structures threatened.

**Ukonom Complex** (3 fires), Six Rivers NF. IMT 2 (Lund). Ten miles east of Orleans, CA. Timber. Active fire behavior. Structures threatened.

**Siskiyou Complex** (3 fires), Klamath NF. IMT 2 (Paul). Eighteen miles southwest of Happy Camp, CA. Conifer and hardwood overstory with heavy timber litter. Active fire behavior with short uphill runs and occasional torching. Campground and residences threatened.

**Gould**, Klamath NF. Nineteen miles southwest of Etna, CA. Timber. Smoldering with isolated torching.

**Humboldt Complex**, Humboldt-Del Norte Unit, Cal Fire. Humboldt County, CA. Timber, slash and grass. Spotting. Numerous residences threatened.

**TGU Lightning Complex** (3 fires). Tehama-Glenn Unit, Cal Fire. Tehama County, CA. Chaparral. Moderate rates of spread.

**Walker**, Sonoma-Lake Napa Unit, Cal Fire. Cal Fire IMT 1 (Morris). Ten miles northeast of Clearlake Oaks, CA. Chaparral. Moderate fire activity with spotting.

**Antelope**, Lassen NF. Seven miles southeast of Paynes Creek, CA. Timber. No new information. Last report unless new information is received.

**LNF June Lightning Complex**, Lassen NF. Sixteen miles southwest of Chester, CA. Timber. No new information. Last report unless new information is received.

**Basin Complex** (2 fires), Los Padres NF. IMT 1 (Dietrich and Molumby). Five miles southeast of Big Sur, CA. Timber, brush and slash. Moderate backing activity with occasional short uphill runs. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations in effect. Highway 1 closed.

**Indians**, Los Padres NF. Unified Command between IMT 1 (Molumby) and Cal Fire IMT 1 (Hutchinson). Eighteen miles west of King City, CA. Timber, chaparral and grass. Active fire behavior with up-slope runs. Numerous structures and cultural resources threatened. Evacuation orders in effect for Arroyo Seco.

**Clover**, Sequoia NF. Transfer of command from IMT 2 Harvey to IMT 2 Johnson initiated. Thirty-two miles north of Weldon, CA. Timber and brush. Backing and creeping with isolated torching, upslope runs and spotting. Residences threatened.

**Oliver**, Merced-Mariposa Unit, Cal Fire. Cal Fire IMT 1 (Hodson). Twelve miles east of Mariposa, CA. Timber, heavy brush and downed fuels. Moderate fire activity. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuation orders in effect.

**Oliver Complex** (4 fires), Sierra NF. Seven miles west of Fish Camp, CA. Timber, heavy brush and downed fuels. No new information.

**Silver Complex** (5 fires), Sierra NF. NIMO (Cable). Twelve miles southeast of Mariposa, CA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior.

**North Mountain**, Stanislaus NF. IMT 2 (Woychak). Seven miles northeast of Groveland, CA. Chaparral and timber. Increased fire activity. Numerous residences and lookout tower threatened.

**Distillery**, Coronado NF. IMT 2 (Small). Ten miles east of Vail, AZ. Timber and grass. Isolated smoldering.

**White Tank**, Coronado NF. IMT 2 (Sciacca). IMT also managing the Nuevo fire. Ten miles east of Arivaca, AZ. Short grass and mesquite. No new information.

**West Fork**, Cimarron District, New Mexico State Forestry. Twenty-eight miles west of Raton, NM. Mixed conifer and juniper with oak understory. Moderate fire activity with isolated torching.

**Hot Air**, Apache-Sitgreaves NF. IMT 2 (Hall). Twenty-nine miles southwest of Alpine, AZ. Ponderosa pine and brush. Moderate surface fire activity. Light precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday. Hwy 191 closed.

**Ethan**, Pima Agency, BIA. IMT 2 (Raley). Twelve miles southwest of Phoenix, AZ. Brush. Running and spotting. Residences threatened. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

**Black Mesa**, San Carlos Agency, BIA. Ten miles northeast of San Carlos, AZ. Brush and grass. Active fire behavior.

**Nuevo**, Coronado NF. Seventeen miles northwest of Nogales, AZ. Brush and grass. No new information.

**Bear Mountain**, Apache - Sitgreaves NF. Confine/contain management strategy. Twenty miles south of Alpine, AZ. Timber and brush. No further information received. Monitor status. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

**Crystal Peak**, San Carlos Agency, BIA. Twenty-three miles south of San Carlos, AZ. Chaparral. Active fire behavior.

**South 1**, Great Dismal Swamp NWR. NIMO (Whitney). Previously reported fire. Twelve miles southeast of Suffolk, VA. Logging slash and blow down. Moderate fire activity with short runs, single and group tree torching and short-range spotting.

**South Cut**, Cumberland Island National Seashore, NPS. Georgia IMT 2 (Cline). Thirteen miles northeast of St. Mary's, Georgia. Timber, scrub and slash. Active fire behavior. Residences threatened. Road closures in effect.

**Knob Complex**, National Forests in North Carolina. Eight miles southeast of Franklin, NC. Hardwood timber. Moderate fire activity. Light precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Santa Anna**, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land six miles northeast of Santa Anna, TX. Pinyon pine, juniper, mesquite and tall grass. Smoldering. Monitor status. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

**Deaton**, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land thirty-nine miles south of Ozona, TX. Brush, pinyon pine, juniper and grass. Minimal fire activity. Monitor status. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

### Lookouts

Lookouts are often better situated to notice the cumulative changes of fire behavior.

● Fire Order #8 says, "Establish lookouts in potentially hazardous situations." Should you utilize lookouts at all times?

- Lookouts should be posted at all times.

● What are you looking for when you are selecting a lookout location?

- Choose a good vantage point, preferably with a good overview of the entire area where firefighters are located, including escape routes and safety zones.
- Utilize aircraft if they are available, but only as a complement to established lookouts on the ground. Never rely exclusively on aircraft as your lookout.

● What are the desired qualities, capabilities, knowledge, and responsibilities of a lookout person?

- Experienced firefighter.
- Solid knowledge of fire behavior and ability to recognize and monitor other environmental hazards.
- Good communicator--keeps the crew advised of fire behavior changes, tracks weather trends and relays the information, informs crew of work progress and updates from the latest strategy and tactical briefings.
- Monitors and accounts for all individuals within his/her assigned area at all times, and will notify others if breaks are needed.

● What is the necessary equipment for a lookout?

- PPE, radio with extra batteries, compass, binoculars, belt weather kit, IAP, map, food, and water.
