Union Hill #2, Texas Forest Service. IMT 2 (Hannemann). Three miles southwest of Baird, TX. Brush and tall grass. Wind-driven fire with torching and spotting. Residences and outbuildings threatened.

Arabella, Texas Forest Service. IMT 2 (Hannemann). Started on private land six miles northwest of Fort Davis, TX. Brush and tall grass. Wind-driven fire. Multiple residences threatened
