Brevard Complex (6 fires), Florida DOF. Florida IMT 2 (Beauchamp). Brevard County, FL. Southern rough. Moderate activity within interior and smoldering. Numerous residences threatened.

Anthony, Texas Forest Service. IMT 2 (Hannemann). Three miles northeast of Monahans, TX. Grass. Residences threatened.

Myakka Cut, Florida DOF. Five miles north of Clewiston, FL. Grass. Moderate fire activity. Cities of Moore Haven and Lakeport, FL threatened.

Mud Swamp New River, National Forests in Florida. Five miles northeast of Sumatra, FL. Southern rough. Minimal fire activity.

LPGA, Florida DOF. Six miles west of Daytona Beach, FL. Southern rough. No new information.
