Lonesome Complex, Rogue River NF. IMT 2 (Batten). Twenty-one miles east of Prospect, OR. Timber. Single and group tree torching. Residences threatened.

Royce Butte, Deschutes NF. IMT 2 (Rapp) ordered. Thirteen miles west of West Crescent, OR. Ponderosa and Lodgepole pine. Active fire with crown runs and long-range spotting. Residences threatened. Evacuations in effect.
