2009 Winter Initial Attack, Texas Forest Service. Texas IMT 2 (Bennett). IMT is supporting multiple fires in west Texas. Acres reported are a cumulative total.

Loco / Healdton, Oklahoma DOF. Five miles east of Loco, OK. Grass. Minimal fire activity. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Cement Mountain Complex, Texas Forest Service. Previously report as Cement Mountain. Started on private land four miles northeast of Graham, TX. Brush and grass. Interior smoldering.

Montague County Complex, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land three miles south of St. Jo, TX. Brush and grass. Interior smoldering.

Ratliff City / Tatums, Oklahoma DOF. One mile northeast of Ratliff City, OK. Grass. Minimal fire activity. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Two Mile Hill Complex, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land eight miles southeast of Holliday, TX. Brush and grass. Interior smoldering.

Cedar Mountain, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land five miles north of Cisco, TX. Interior smoldering.

Roberts Branch, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land 11 miles north of Jacksboro, TX. Brush and grass. Interior smoldering.

Black, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land nine miles northeast of Albany, TX. Grass. Interior smoldering.

Mulhall / Payne County, Oklahoma DOF. Five miles northeast of Mulhall, OK. Grass. Minimal fire activity. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Brushy Mountain, Chicksaw Agency, BIA. Two miles northwest of Oswalt, OK. Hardwood litter and grass. Minimal fire activity.

Lindsay, Oklahoma DOF. Six miles west of Lindsay, OK. Grass. Minimal fire activity. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Fox Graham, Chickasaw Agency, BIA. Two miles northeast of Fox, OK. Hardwood litter and grass. Minimal fire activity. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Electra West, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land one mile northwest of Electra, TX. Grass. Interior smoldering.

Choctaw, Oklahoma DOF. One mile east of Midwest City, OK. Grass. Minimal fire activity. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Breckenridge, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land one mile north of Breckenridge, TX. Grass. Interior creeping.

Velma West, Oklahoma DOF. Five miles southwest of Velma, OK. Grass. Minimal fire activity. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Beard Mountain, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land 45 miles west of Ft. Stockton, TX. Grass. Active fire behavior.

Black Pup, Osage Agency, BIA. Four miles southwest of Pawhuska, OK. Grass. Creeping and smoldering.

Arbuckle, Oklahoma DOF. Four miles southeast of Davis, OK. Grass. Smoldering. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Velma, Oklahoma DOF. Two miles southwest of Velma, OK. Tall grass. Moderate fire activity.

1148 Complex, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land 10 miles north of Brad, TX. Brush and tall grass. Interior smoldering.

Wellston, Oklahoma DOF. Four miles southwest of Wellston, OK. Brush. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday. No further information received.

Grosvenor, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land three miles northwest of Grosvenor, TX. Brush and grass. Interior smoldering. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Velma East, Oklahoma DOF. Six miles southeast of Velma, OK. Grass. No further information received.
