**Predictive Services Discussion:** Dry and gusty winds will continue today across much of the Western U.S. including the Great Basin and Southwest. Showers and thunderstorms are expected across the Pacific Northwest and Northern Rockies today with a strong upper level low pressure system. There will also be thunderstorms stretching along the east side of the Rocky Mountains southward through the Southern Plains where there is abundant moisture available. A slow moving cold front extending from the Ohio Valley through the Lower Mississippi Valley will be a trigger for wet thunderstorms across much of the Eastern U.S. Southwest Alaska will see showers and thunderstorms again today but the Eastern half of the state will see some warming and drying with higher pressure building over the area.
