Area Command Team (Muir) has been assigned to Southwest Regional Support in Tucson, AZ for large fire support.

**Frye**, Coronado, NF. IMT 1 (Poncin) Nine miles west of Swift Trail Junction, AZ. Timber, brush and chaparral. Active fire behavior with torching and backing. Residences threatened. Road, area and trail closures in effect.

**Hilltop**, San Carlos Agency, BIA. Twenty-four miles west of Whiteriver, AZ. Timber, short grass and light logging slash. Active fire behavior with wind driven runs, group torching and short range spotting. Road closures in effect.

**Burro**, Coronado, NF. IMT 1 (Day). Eight miles northeast of Tucson, AZ. Tall grass, brush and short grass. Active fire behavior with running and short range spotting. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

**Goodwin**, Prescott, NF. IMT 1 (Pierson). Eight miles southwest of Mayer, AZ. Chaparral and short grass. Moderate fire behavior with single tree torching, flanking and backing. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations, road, area and trail closures in effect.

**Tiffany**, Southeast District, New Mexico State Forestry. Thirty miles south of Socorro, NM. Chaparral and hardwood litter. Active fire behavior with group torching, single tree torching and short range spotting. Structures threatened.

**Swisshelms**, Southeast Area, Arizona DOF. Ten miles east of Elfrida, AZ. Tall grass, brush and short grass. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and backing. Residences threatened.

**Gentry**, Apache-Sitgreaves, NF. Ten miles southwest of Heber, AZ. Heavy logging slash and tall grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Road and area closures in effect.

**Saddle**, Coronado, NF. Twenty miles north of Douglas, AZ. Short grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior.

**Whitman**, Carson, NF. Eighteen miles northeast of Red River, NM. Timber. No new information. Last report unless new information received.

**Predictive Services Discussion:** Breezy and dry conditions will create pockets of critical fire weather conditions across the Columbia Basin in Washington and Oregon while a weak cold front moves east across the Northern Rockies creating scattered wet and dry storms. The convection is expected to extend southward along the Continental Divide becoming all wet entering Colorado and New Mexico. Further west, a very strong area of high pressure will begin to develop over the Southwest and Southern California. The emergence of this high pressure will mark the beginning of an extended very hot and dry spell for the entire west that will begin mid-week. Looking north to Alaska, warm and dry conditions will continue across the interior along with a chance for mainly afternoon storms over the Brooks and Alaska Ranges.
