Four MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel have been deployed to Port Hueneme, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally. Their respective units are as follows: 153rd Airlift Wing (WY Air National Guard), 302nd Airlift Wing (CO Air Force Reserve), 146th Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard), and 152nd Airlift Wing (NV Air National Guard).

Sixty Fireline management personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest Area.

Two hundred forty-five soldiers from the 14th Brigade Engineer Battalion and the 1st Battalion, 17th Infantry Regiment based out of Joint Base Lewis McChord (JBLM) are deployed in support of wildland fire operations on the Boise National Forest. NIMO (Team 2) is assigned to support the military contingent.

Wapiti, Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 5) and CIMT (GB Team 3). IMTs are also managing the Middle Fork Complex. Fourteen miles west of Stanley, ID. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, group torching and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Middle Fork Complex (2 fires), Boise NF, USFS. Nine miles east of Garden Valley, ID. Timber. Extreme fire behavior with uphill runs, group torching and spotting. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Fish Creek, Bridger-Teton NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 1) mobilizing. Previously reported incident. Twenty-two miles southeast of Moran, WY. Heavy slash and timber litter. Active fire behavior with flanking, wind-driven runs and group torching. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Flat, Southwest Area, Idaho Department of Lands. CIMT (GB Team 6). Eleven miles north of Idaho City, ID. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, isolated torching and short-range spotting. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Boulder, Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 2). CIMT (RM Team 2) mobilizing. IMT is also managing the Wolf Creek, Snag, Dollar and Goat fires. Nine miles southwest of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with creeping and torching. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wolf Creek, Payette NF, USFS. Eleven miles northwest of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Road and trail closures in effect.

Snag, Boise NF, USFS. Ten miles east of Cascade, ID. Timber. Active fire behavior with group torching, spotting and backing. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Dollar, Boise NF, USFS. Eighteen miles northeast of Cascade, ID. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with group torching, backing and spotting. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Goat, Boise NF, USFS. Eleven miles southeast of Cascade, ID. Timber. Active fire behavior with group torching, spotting and backing. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Limepoint, Payette NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 4). Three miles southwest of Cuprum, ID. Timber, brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with smoldering, single tree torching and creeping. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hobson, Ely District, BLM. Forty-five miles northwest of Ely, NV. Timber, brush and slash. Minimal fire behavior. Sage-grouse habitat threatened.

* **Iron Peak**, Dixie NF, USFS. Five miles northeast of Paragonah, UT. Chaparral and brush. Extreme fire behavior with running, crowning and spotting. Residences threatened.

Raglan, Winnemucca District, BLM. Ten miles southwest of Winnemucca, NV. Brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior. Structures threatened.

Merna Butte, Bridger-Teton NF, USFS. Eight miles west of Daniel, WY. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, smoldering and single tree torching.

Leeds Creek, Bridger-Teton NF, USFS. Eighteen miles southwest of Dubois, WY. Heavy slash and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Area, road and trail closure in effect.

Diamond Complex (5 fires), Umpqua NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 4). IMT is also managing the Middle Fork fire. Eighteen miles southwest of Chemult, OR. Brush, timber and slash. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, isolated torching and smoldering. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Middle Fork, Crater Lake NP, NPS. Fourteen miles northeast of Union Creek, OR. Brush, timber and slash. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, isolated torching and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Willamette Complex (5 fires), Willamette NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 7). Transfer of command from CIMT (AK Team 3) to CIMT (EA Team 1) will occur tomorrow. IMTs are also managing the Ore fire. Eight miles southeast of Oakridge, OR. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Ore, Willamette NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Blue River, OR. Brush and timber. Closed timber litter and timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Pioneer, Southeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (NW Team 3). IMT is also managing the Easy and Stayman fires. Started on private land 10 miles southeast of Stehekin, WA. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, backing and smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Easy, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Seventeen miles west of Mazama, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Stayman, Southeast Region, Washington DNR. Six miles southwest of Chelan, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with running, wind-driven runs and uphill runs. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

Williams Mine, Gifford Pinchot NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 13). Four miles northwest of Trout Lake, WA. Brush, timber and light slash. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Numerous structures, communities and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Whisky Creek, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 10). IMT is also managing the Sandstone fire. Six miles southeast of Cascade Locks, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Sandstone, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Nine miles southwest of Ripplebrook, OR. Brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Lane 1, East Lane Unit, ODF. IMT 1 (ODF Team 1). CIMT (AK Team 1) mobilizing. Fifteen miles southeast of Springfield, OR. Timber, closed timber litter and light slash. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and smoldering. Structures, energy and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Homestead Complex (6 Fires), Umpqua NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 6). Thirty miles northeast of Glide, OR. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Moderate fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Battle Mountain Complex (2 fires), Pendleton Unit, Oregon DOF. Eight miles north of Ukiah, OR. Grass, hardwood litter and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Crazy Creek, Ochoco NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (CA Team 1) back to the local unit will occur today. Sixteen miles northeast of Paulina, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering, backing and creeping. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

2620 Road, Olympic Region, Washington DNR. Twenty miles northwest of Bremerton, WA. Timber and slash. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and single tree torching. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Predictive Services Discussion:

South to southwest winds of 15-30 mph with gusts of 30 to 50 mph amid relative humidity of 5-20% will develop across much of the Great Basin into western/central Wyoming today. Above normal temperatures are likely to continue in Montana and Wyoming with minimum RH below 25%, although winds will be lighter in Montana with fewer thunderstorms. Winds will be breezy across the Inland Northwest as well, with isolated mixed wet and dry thunderstorms creating the potential for new ignitions. However, showers are likely in the Cascades westward, with snow possible above 8,000 feet, along with much cooler temperatures and high humidity providing continued relief. Monsoon moisture will continue in Arizona and spread across much of eastern Utah, New Mexico west of the Divide, and Colorado for scattered to widespread wet thunderstorms.

Temperatures in the southern Plains will remain above normal with afternoon relative humidity as low as 10% and southerly winds of 12-20 mph and gusts 20-35. In addition, slightly increased moisture in central Texas will lead to isolated to scattered mixed wet and dry thunderstorms for likely new ignitions. In the Deep South, very dry conditions with relative humidity as low as 25% will continue. Dry air will continue to spread across the Appalachians and Ohio Valley, but temperatures are likely to remain below normal.
