Pack Trail, Bridger-Teton NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 10). Twenty-five miles southeast of Moran, WY. Timber. Active fire behavior with group torching, flanking and short-range spotting. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations, area and trail closures in effect.

Yellow Lake, Uinta-Wasatch-Cache NF, USFS. Ten miles southeast of Francis, UT. Timber and medium slash. Active fire behavior with group torching, flanking and backing. Structures threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Lava, Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (RM Team 2). Twelve miles southwest of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Numerous residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wapiti, Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 4). IMT is also managing the Frog fire. Fourteen miles west of Stanley, ID. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, single tree torching and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Frog, Sawtooth NF, USFS. Nineteen miles southeast of Stanley, ID. Grass, brush and timber litter. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Red Rock, Salmon-Challis NF, USFS. Fifteen miles west of Salmon, ID. Timber and light slash. Active fire behavior with backing, single tree torching and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Goat, Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 6). IMT is also managing the Snag fire and the Middle Fork Complex. Eleven miles southeast of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, backing and flanking. Energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Rail Ridge, Prineville, District, BLM. Transfer of command from CIMT (AK Team 3) to CIMT (NW Team 8) will occur tomorrow. Fifty-one miles northwest of Burns, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Homestead Complex (4 fires), Umpqua NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 12). IMT is also managing the Diamond Complex. Thirty miles northeast of Glide, OR. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Diamond Complex (2 fires), Umpqua NF, USFS. Eighteen miles southwest of Chemult, OR. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Willamette Complex (4 fires), Willamette NF, USFS. Eight miles southeast of Oakridge, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, creeping and isolated torching. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Goosmus, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Started on private land five miles north of Curlew, WA. Grass, timber and brush. Active fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Red, Deschutes NF, USFS. Eighteen miles west of Crescent, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, smoldering and isolated torching. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Predictive Services Discussion:

A dry cold front will move through the Northwest, northern Rockies, and northern Plains today. Breezy and dry westerly winds of 15-25 mph with gusts 30-45 mph amid relative humidity of 5-20% will develop across eastern Oregon into the northern Great Basin, northern/central Rockies, and the northern Plains. Dry southwesterly winds of 15-20 mph amid relative humidity of 20-35% will create elevated conditions from the Texas panhandle northeast into the Upper Great Lakes, as well. Well above normal temperatures up to 105°F will continue across much of California into the southern Great Basin and Southwest, with afternoon relative humidity remaining below 15% and very poor overnight recovery for mid-slopes and ridges. A weakening cold front will bring isolated showers to the Northeast and Mid-Atlantic, while dry conditions are expected in the Southeast.
