Red Canyon, Wind River/Bighorn Basin District, BLM. CIMT (RM Team 2). Eleven miles east of Thermopolis, WY. Grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, uphill runs and short-range spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

Crosho, Medicine Bow-Routt NF, USFS. Eight miles northwest of Yampa, CO. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, backing and creeping. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Lee, White River Field Office, BLM. Transfer of command from CIMT (RM Team 3) to CIMT (NR Team 1) will occur today. Eleven miles southwest of Meeker, CO. Grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Community of Meeker and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Stoner Mesa, San Juan NF, USFS. CIMT (RM Team 1). Eleven miles northeast of Dolores, CO. Timber and timber litter. Moderate fire behavior with torching and short-range spotting. Community of Rico and numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Spring Creek, Washakie County, WY. Thirty miles east of Worland, WY. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, backing and flanking. Road closures in effect. Structures threatened.

Turner Gulch, Grand Junction Field Office, BLM. CIMT (NR Team 3). Eight miles northeast of Gateway, CO. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Community of Gateway threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sleeper Ranch, Wind River/Bighorn Basin District, BLM. Twenty-six miles south of Cody, WY. Brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with creeping and backing. Sage grouse habitat, energy infrastructure and structures threatened.

Cottonwood Peak, Elko District, BLM. CIMT (EA Team 1). Three miles north of Tuscarora, NV. Brush and grass. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, flanking and backing. Community of Tuscarora, energy infrastructure and sage-grouse habitat threatened.

Rock, Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 6). Five miles northeast of Donnelly, ID. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with group torching, short-range spotting and uphill runs. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Chin Creek, Ely District, BLM. Fifty miles northeast of Ely, NV. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Sage-grouse habitat threatened. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Sand Creek, Idaho Falls District, BLM. Twenty miles north of Rexburg, ID. Grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Residences threatened.

Box, Boise District, BLM. Fifty-six miles southwest of Grandview, ID. Timber and grass. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and single tree torching. Residences threatened.

Rancho, Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District. Ten miles north of Reno, NV. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Residences threatened.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Locally breezy south to southwest winds 10-20 mph with gusts to 35 mph across the inland Northwest, northern Great Basin, and into western Montana. Low RH of 7-20% and poor overnight recovery is expected across the Great Basin, with higher RH above 25% farther north and west across northern California into the Pacific Northwest and northern Rockies. Isolated mixed wet/dry thunderstorms are possible across central Idaho and into Montana and northern Wyoming. Cooler than north temperatures are expected across northern California and the Pacific Northwest, with near to above normal temperatures across the remainder of the west.

The monsoon moisture plume moves over the Southwest and east of the Divide in Colorado as minimum. Isolated to scattered showers and thunderstorms will persist in New Mexico and east of the Divide in Colorado, but isolated mixed/wet dry thunderstorms will remain possible from central Arizona to the West Slope.

For the southern Plains, southerly, locally breezy winds continue with lower RH of 20 to 30% across the Southern Plains. Isolated showers and thunderstorms are expected in the Northeast, with most areas remaining dry although RH will be higher and above 30%. Isolated showers and thunderstorms are also expected along the Gulf Coast and Southeast, with isolated to scattered showers and thunderstorms across the remainder of the Great Plains as well as the Midwest.
