Predictive Services Discussion:

A cold front will continue to trek eastward across the eastern US on Tuesday, while high pressure shifts east of the Four Corners allowing for a weak stream of mid to high level moisture into the Southwest, Great Basin, and central Rockies. This will result in shower and thunderstorm activity increasing across these regions, with a mix of wet and dry thunderstorms. A mix of wet and dry thunderstorms are expected across interior Oregon and northern California today, with a few storms ongoing across northern California this morning. Overall, dry thunderstorms are most likely across portions of Nevada, Utah, Colorado, Western Wyoming, eastern Idaho and into portions of Oregon and northern California. Cumulus buildups and virga will increase gusty afternoon winds across the entire inland western US due to outflows. Nocturnal showers and thunderstorms are likely across Nevada, Utah, and Arizona tonight, with thunderstorms expected to diminish everywhere but Nevada by Wednesday morning. In addition, well above normal temperatures are expected across the Great Basin with afternoon RH in the single digits and teens. A warming and drying trend continues across the Alaska Interior, with isolated showers and thunderstorms remaining possible in the eastern Interior and eastern Brooks Range.
