Active fire behavior with backing, torching and spotting. Numerous residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Road closures in effect.

Aggie Creek, Fairbanks Area, Alaska DOF. Started on Alaska DNR land 23 miles northwest of Fairbanks, AK. Chaparral and timber. Active fire behavior with crowning, backing and spotting. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Road closures in effect.

Bear Creek, Fairbanks Area, Alaska DOF. CIMT (AK Team 1). CIMT is also managing the Saint George Creek incident. Started on Alaska Native Corporation land 14 miles northwest of Healy, AK. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with uphill runs, wind-driven runs and group torching. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area and trail closures in effect.

Saint George Creek, Fairbanks Area, Alaska, DOF. Started on Alaska DNR land 30 miles southwest of Salcha, AK. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with uphill runs, wind-driven runs and group torching. Residences threatened

Nenana Ridge Complex (2 fires), Fairbanks Area, Alaska DOF. Previously reported incident. Started on Alaska DNR land 20 miles southwest of Fairbanks, AK. Timber, hardwood litter and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, group torching and spotting. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Seven Mile Lookout, Tok Area, Alaska DOF. Started on Alaska DNR land seven miles southwest of Tok, AK. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Residences threatened. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Temperatures moderate over western portions of the Pacific Northwest as heat moves to the inland Pacific Northwest and Northern Rockies on Wednesday. East of the Cascades, critically hot, dry, and windy conditions will develop, especially in the Cascade gaps. A mix of wet and dry thunderstorms will kick off early this morning across the western Great Basin, inland Pacific Northwest, western Wyoming and western Montana.

Throughout the afternoon, showers and thunderstorms will significantly increase in coverage across the Southwest, Great Basin, and into the Rockies, with outflow wind gusts of 20-30 mph common. Some strong storms may develop across eastern Oregon, central Idaho, Montana, and the western Dakotas as well as the Great Lakes, with outflow winds up to 60 mph possible. Gusty winds will also develop east of the Front Range. A warming and drying trend continues across the Alaska Interior, with isolated showers and thunderstorms remaining possible in the eastern Interior and eastern Brooks Range.
