Predictive Services Discussion:

Southwest flow aloft will overspread much of the West today bringing a drier airmass to most areas, including the Southwest. However, isolated to scattered mixed wet and dry thunderstorms will develop across much of Montana into Wyoming, with the wettest storms over eastern Montana. Minimum relative humidity across most of the West will be moderate from 12-25%, but low minimum RH of 5-15 is expected across the lower elevations of southeastern California into the central and southern Great Basin and West Slope. Southwest winds will be light overall, but strongest from southeast Nevada into Utah, the Upper Snake River Plains, and western Wyoming where gusts up to 35 mph are possible creating areas of elevated conditions. In the eastern US, showers and thunderstorms are expected in the Upper Midwest, with scattered showers and thunderstorms southwestward into central Texas. Showers and thunderstorms will continue in Florida and along the Carolina Coast with Tropical Depression Three off the coast which is expected to develop into a tropical storm before making landfall in South Carolina late tonight. Hot, dry, and locally windy conditions are expected across Alaska again today, with widespread temperatures above 80°F across the Interior and the North Slope.
