Predictive Services Discussion:

Isolated to possibly scattered mixed wet and dry thunderstorms are forecast over far northern California into southern and central Oregon from late afternoon through the evening. Temperatures will be 5-20°F above normal across the northwestern US, with relative humidity generally 8-20% across much of the Intermountain West. Dry and breezy conditions are likely from along and east of the southern Sierra into portions of central and southern Nevada. Isolated to scattered mixed wet and dry thunderstorms will continue across southeast Arizona and much of New Mexico, especially along and east of the Continental Divide. Wetter thunderstorms are expected east of the Divide from New Mexico through Colorado and onto the southern and central High Plains. Severe thunderstorms are likely from northeast New Mexico through much of the central and northern Plains and into Minnesota as well. Isolated to scattered thunderstorms are likely across much of the southern and eastern US, with remnants of the Tropical Storm Chanal moving over Virginia. In Alaska, scattered to possibly widespread showers and thunderstorms are forecast across much of the Interior into south-central Alaska, with near to below normal temperatures across the state. Gusty trade winds will continue across the Hawaiian Islands with dry conditions continuing on leeward sides.
