Predictive Services Discussion:

Isolated to scattered mixed wet and dry thunderstorms are forecast from far northern California and southern and central Oregon into central and southern Idaho and southwest Montana during the afternoon and evening. There is a chance that isolated thunderstorms may continue overnight in portions of northeast Oregon, southeast Washington, central and north Idaho, and western Montana. Temperatures will be 10-20°F above normal across the northwestern US, with minimum relative humidity of 5-20% across most of the Intermountain West. Sustained south-southwest winds of 10-20 mph gusting 25-35 mph amid minimum relative humidity of 5-15% will result in elevated to locally critical conditions across portions of southern, central, and eastern Nevada. Gusty Cascade gap winds are also expected with westerly sustained winds of 15-20 mph and gusts of 25-35 mph amid minimum relative humidity of 8-20% leading to elevated and locally critical conditions. Thunderstorm chances and coverage are likely to diminish across the Southwest and Colorado, but isolated thunderstorms are still forecast in portions of southeast Arizona, southern and eastern New Mexico, and eastern Colorado. Scattered to widespread thunderstorms are forecast across much of the central and eastern US, with strong to severe thunderstorms likely from the southern Plains into lower Ohio Valley and from the Carolinas into the Northeast. In Alaska, cooler, cloudier conditions are expected with scattered to widespread showers and chances of isolated thunderstorms across the Interior. Dry and breezy conditions will continue across the Hawaiian Islands, but winds will be weaker than in previous days.
