Predictive Services Discussion:

Above normal temperatures will spread across the West, with the greatest anomalies of 10-15°F above normal in California and the Northwest. Minimum relative humidity of 5-20% will be widespread across the Intermountain West, lowest from California through the Great Basin into the central and southern Rockies. Poor overnight recovery is expected from California to the southern Rockies, as well. Winds overall are expected to be light across the West, but locally breezy westerly winds gusting to 25 mph will occur in the Greater Four Corners. Isolated mixed wet and dry thunderstorms will develop near and east of the Divide in Colorado and New Mexico, with isolated storms possible on the Mogollon Rim. The thunderstorms will be wetter in the adjacent High Plains. Scattered showers and thunderstorms, a few severe, will develop along and ahead of a cold front from the central and southern Plains northeast into the Great Lakes, while isolated showers and thunderstorms are expected across much of the rest of the eastern US. The warming and drying trend will continue in Alaska, with minimum relative humidity of 25-35% across the Interior amid widespread temperatures in the 70s.
