Deer Creek, Southeast Area, Utah DOF. CIMT (GB Team 4). Twenty-five miles southeast of Moab, UT. Timber, chaparral and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, creeping and group torching. Several communities threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Monroe Canyon, Fishlake NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 3). Three miles east of Monroe, UT. Timber. Extreme fire behavior with crowning, uphill runs and spotting. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

White Sage, Arizona Strip District, BLM. CIMT (GB Team 6). Fifteen miles southeast of Fredonia, AZ. Timber and brush. Extreme fire behavior with running, wind-driven runs and short crown runs. Several communities and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Forsyth, Dixie NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 2). Thirty miles north of St. George, UT. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with torching, creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hot Canyon, Elko District, BLM. Ten miles northwest of Montello, NV. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures and sage-grouse habitat threatened.

Big, Carson City District, BLM. Eight miles southwest of Hawthorne, NV. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior.

Gap, West Desert District, BLM. Started on state land five miles southeast of Scipio, UT. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Grizzly Complex, Medford Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (ODF Team 3). Twenty miles west of Medford, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Several communities threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

Elk, Klamath Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (ODF Team 1). Seven miles southwest of Beatty, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with spotting, single tree torching and smoldering. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

Hope, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (NW Team 8). Started on private land 15 miles north of Kettle Falls, WA. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, torching and spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Pomas, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 12). Thirty-six miles northwest of Entiat, WA. Grass, timber and light slash. Active fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Western Pines, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Started on private land 10 miles north of Davenport, WA. Closed timber litter and timber. Moderate fire behavior with smoldering, creeping and backing. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Long Point, Monument Unit, Oregon DOF. Eight miles east of Spray, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. No new information.

Highland, Prineville District, BLM. Started on private land one mile south of Prineville, OR. Brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

Bear Gulch, Olympic NF, USFS. Ten miles northwest of Hoodspport, WA. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Cram, Prineville District, BLM. CIMT (NW Team 10) mobilizing. Fifteen miles north of Madras, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Extreme fire behavior with crowning, running and spotting. Residences threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

* **Greenacres**, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Started on county land 5 miles north of Omak, WA. Grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, running and long-range spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

Coyote, Vale District, BLM. Nineteen miles south of Jordan Vally, OR. Brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with smoldering. Structures and sage-grouse habitat threatened.

Active fire behavior with creeping torching and spotting. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Himalaya Road, Fairbanks Area, Alaska DOF. Transfer of command from CIMT (RM Team 2). CIMT is also managing the Aggie Creek incident. Started on Alaska DNR land 12 miles northwest of Fox, AK. Chaparral and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Numerous residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

Aggie Creek, Fairbanks Area, Alaska DOF. Started on Alaska DNR land 23 miles northwest of Fairbanks, AK. Chaparral and timber. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, isolated torching and smoldering. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Road closures in effect.

Tsukon, Upper Yukon Zone, BLM. Started on Alaska Native Corporation land 17 miles northwest of Venetie, AK. Closed timber litter and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering, creeping and group torching.

Seven Mile Lookout, Tok Area, Alaska DOF. Started on Alaska DNR land seven miles southwest of Tok, AK. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and backing. Residences threatened.

Goldrun Complex (4 fires), Galena Zone, BLM. Started on NPS land 13 miles northwest of Ambler, AK. Hardwood litter, timber and brush. Active fire behavior with torching. Residences threatened. Last narrative report unless significant activity occurs.

Roundabout Complex (3 fires), Galena Zone, BLM. Started on FWS land eight miles southwest of Huslia, AK. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and flanking. Structures threatened. Last narrative report unless significant activity occurs.

Wheeler, Galena Zone, BLM. Previously reported incident. Thirty miles north of Huslia, AK. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Last narrative report unless significant activity occurs.

Christian, Upper Yukon Zone, BLM. Previously reported incident. Started on FWS land 50 miles northeast of Venetie, AK. Timber and hardwood litter. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, smoldering and single tree torching. Last narrative report unless significant activity occurs.

Predictive Services Discussion:

A strong cold front will move into the northern Great Basin and stall, with southwesterly sustained winds 15-25 mph gusting 30-45 mph amid RH of 7-15% across southeast Nevada into southwest Utah creating elevated to critical conditions. Breezy west to northwest winds will develop in eastern Oregon into the Sierra Front and Snake River Plain for elevated conditions, as well. An upper-level wave along the front will also trigger isolated to scattered mainly dry thunderstorms with strong outflow wind gusts up to 50 mph from central and northeast Nevada into Utah, northern Arizona, and the West Slope. Numerous new ignitions and several new large fires are expected, and any very active fires in this area will also be capable of producing thunderstorms and additional lightning. A few dry thunderstorms are likely to continue overnight for Utah and the West Slope.

Behind the front, temperatures will moderate for the Inland Northwest but remain above normal west of the Cascades due to light easterly flow. Scattered to widespread showers and thunderstorms are expected east of the Divide in Montana and northern Wyoming, with some areas likely to receive 1" or more of rainfall. Isolated to scattered mixed wet and dry thunderstorms will continue to develop in the Southwest, with wetter storms focused in southeast Arizona and most of New Mexico. Drier conditions are expected in Texas today, while strong thunderstorms develop in the northern Plains to Upper Midwest, with another round of scattered to widespread thunderstorms in Florida. Cooler conditions will return to Interior Alaska today, with rain expected for the western Interior.
