Himalaya Road, Fairbanks Area, Alaska DOF. CIMT (SW Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Aggie Creek incident. Started on Alaska DNR land 12 miles northwest of Fox, AK. Chaparral and timber. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, isolated torching and smoldering. Numerous residences threatened. Road closures in effect.

Aggie Creek, Fairbanks Area, Alaska DOF. Started on Alaska DNR land 23 miles northwest of Fairbanks, AK. Chaparral and timber. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, isolated torching and smoldering. Residences threatened. Road closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Bear Creek, Fairbanks Area, Alaska DOF. CIMT (AK Team 1). CIMT is also managing the Saint George Creek incident. Started on Alaska Native Corporation land 14 miles northwest of Healy, AK. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area and trail closures in effect.

Saint George Creek, Fairbanks Area, Alaska, DOF. Started on Alaska DNR land 30 miles southwest of Salcha, AK. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened.

Ptarmigan Complex (4 fires), Upper Yukon Zone, BLM. Two miles south of Central, AK. Brush, timber and hardwood litter. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Numerous residences threatened. Area closures in effect.

Seven Mile Lookout, Tok Area, Alaska DOF. Started on Alaska DNR land seven miles southwest of Tok, AK. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and single tree torching. Residences threatened. Precipitation occurred over the fire yesterday.

Oskawalik, Southwest Area, Alaska DOF. Nine miles south of Crooked Creek, AK. Timber. Minimal fire behavior. Residences threatened.

Runt, Upper Yukon Zone, BLM. Eighty-seven miles southwest of Circle, AK. Brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior. Structures threatened.

Roundabout Complex (4 fires), Galena Zone, BLM. Started on FWS land 8 miles southwest of Huslia, AK. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior. Structures threatened.

* **Monte Cristo Creek**, Fairbanks Area, Alaska DOF. Started on Alaska DNR land 33 miles east of Salcha, AK. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with isolated torching. Last narrative report unless significant activity occurs.

Kandik, Upper Yukon Zone, BLM. Previously reported incident. Started on NPS land 53 miles northwest of Eagle, AK. Timber, hardwood litter and brush. Moderate fire behavior with creeping. Structures threatened. Last narrative report unless significant activity occurs.

Nowitna, Tanana Zone, BLM. Previously reported incident. Fifty-six miles northwest of Telida, AK. Timber. Minimal fire behavior. Structures threatened. Last narrative report unless significant activity occurs.

Predictive Services Discussion:

A warming trend is expected across the West today with temperatures rising to 10-15oF above normal. Locally breezy westerly winds are expected across the Great Basin, Wyoming, West Slope, and Arizona amid relative humidity of 5-20%, lowest in the Greater Four Corners into southern Nevada. Isolated dry thunderstorms will develop in east-central Nevada to northeast Utah and far northwest Nevada, with an isolated thunderstorm or two possible in the central Sierra. Monsoon moisture will remain limited in New Mexico, with isolated showers and thunderstorms confined to south-central New Mexico and east of the central mountains, with isolated dry thunderstorms possible near the Divide.

A cold front will move through the central Plains and Great Lakes, with showers and thunderstorms along and ahead of the front from the Front Range and central Plains through the Mid-Mississippi Valley and into the Great Lakes. Scattered showers and thunderstorms will persist from the northern Gulf Coast and Florida into the Ohio and Tennessee Valleys. The warming trend will continue across the central and eastern Alaska Interior today and begin to spread into the western Interior, but isolated showers and thunderstorms remain possible in the southeastern Interior and south-central Alaska.
