**Fish Hook**, North Carolina Forest Service. Five miles north of Columbus, NC. Hardwood litter, timber and light slash. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Big Ridge**, Chattahoochee-Oconee NF, USFS. CIMT (SA Team 3) mobilizing. Eight miles northeast of Clayton, GA. Harwood litter and timber. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs and flanking. Structures threatened. Road and trail closures in effect.

\* **Alarka #5**, North Carolina Forest Service. Five miles south of Bryson City, NC. Hardwood litter. Active fire behavior with running. Residences threatened.

## **Predictive Services Discussion:**

Low afternoon relative humidity of 10-25% will continue across the Appalachians today, and spread to much of the East Coast, but winds will be lighter and generally near or less than 10 mph. However, dry easterly winds of 10-15 mph will create areas of elevated conditions across Florida. Dry and breezy south to southwesterly sustained winds of 15-25 mph with gusts to 40 mph amid relative humidity of 15-30% will create areas of elevated conditions across. However, scattered to widespread showers and thunderstorms will spread across much of central and East Texas bringing significant relief and areas of heavy rain. Farther west, isolated to scattered mixed wet and dry thunderstorms will develop across. West Texas into portions of New Mexico and southern Colorado, with the driest storms near the Continental Divide.

A strong Pacific storm will move into the Northwest, with strong winds and areas of low humidity expected across much of the Great Basin and southeast Oregon. Moderate to heavy precipitation is expected near and west of the Cascades, gradually spreading into the northern Great Basin and northern Rockies late in the afternoon and overnight. Scattered showers and thunderstorms are likely to develop farther east across the northern Plains into the Midwest, as well. Much of Alaska will remain dry except for scattered snow showers across the central Interior. Light southeasterly trade winds will continue across Hawai'i, but with fewer showers than early this week.
