Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel have been deployed to Klamath Falls, OR and two MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel have been deployed to Channel Islands, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally. Their respective units are as follows: 302nd (Peterson SFB, CO) and 152nd AW (Reno, NV) to Klamath Falls, OR and 146th AW (Channel Islands, CA) and 153rd AW (Cheyenne, WY) to Channel Islands, CA.

Six US Army HH-60 MEDEVAC Helicopters from the 1st Air Cavalry Brigade (Fort Hood, TX) have been deployed to California to support wildland fire operations nationally.

Blue, Klamath NF, USFS. Ten miles east of Happy Camp, CA. Chaparral and timber. Active fire behavior with running, group torching and short-range spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Crown Creek, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (NW Team 12) mobilizing. Eighteen miles northeast of Kettle Falls, WA. Closed timber litter and timber. Extreme fire behavior with crowning, group torching and spotting. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations in effect.

Wildcat, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 10) mobilizing. Thirty miles west of Naches, WA. Timber. Extreme fire behavior with crowning, torching and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Bear Gulch, Olympic NF, USFS. Ten miles northwest of Hoodport, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Residences threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Flat, Sisters Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (ODF Team 3). Seven miles west of Culver, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Numerous structures threatened.

Pomas, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Thirty-six miles northwest of Entiat, WA. Grass, timber and light slash. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Moderate fire behavior with group torching, creeping and smoldering. Numerous residences and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Ransome, Kootenai NF, USFS. Eleven miles northwest of Libby, MT. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, short-range spotting and isolated torching. Residences threatened. Road closures in effect.

Sunset, Pend Oreille Area Office, Idaho Department of Lands. Twenty-six miles north of Coeur d'Alene, ID. Brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Infrastructure threatened.

West Fork, Custer Gallatin NF, USFS. Twenty-three miles northwest of West Yellowstone, MT. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Island Creek, Nez Perce-Clearwater NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 2). CIMT is also managing the East and Mire incidents. Fourteen miles east of Elk City, ID. Brush, closed timber litter and timber. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Road closures in effect.

East, Nez Perce-Clearwater NF, USFS. Forty-five miles southwest of Missoula, MT. Timber, brush and closed timber litter. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Road closures in effect.

Predictive Services Discussion:

A high-pressure ridge expands across the Western US for warming temperatures and RHs in the low teens at most valley locations. Temperatures continue to peg much above normal over California, the Inland Northwest and Northern Rockies. Isolated storms are possible over western Montana, otherwise the west is generally dry, even down into most of Arizona. General winds will be light across the West with locally breezy southwest winds over northwest California and central Oregon. Active fire behavior is expected on fires across California and the Northwest/Northern Rockies.

A band of light showers develops again over the eastern Plains and central/southern Texas, bringing some temporary relief to the drier conditions there. Otherwise, the Eastern US is dry aside from some light showers over the Tennessee Valley with temperatures near normal and RHs in the 30s. Winds will generally be on the lighter side.
