**Lower Sugarloaf**, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Labor Mountain incident. Twelve miles northeast of Leavenworth, WA. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, flanking and group torching. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Labor Mountain**, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Ten miles north of Cle Elum, WA. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, flanking and group torching. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Crown Creek**, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (NW Team 12). CIMT is also managing the Katy Creek incident. Eighteen miles northeast of Kettle Falls, WA. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and torching. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

**Katy Creek**, Colville NF, USFS. Six miles northwest of Kettle Falls, WA. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and spotting. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

**Rattlesnake**, Colville Agency, BIA. CIMT (NW Team 7). CIMT is also managing the Lynx Mountain incident. Two miles west of Seven Bays, WA. Timber, brush and grass. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and torching. Residences and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

**Lynx Mountain**, Colville Agency, BIA. Twenty-nine miles west of Chewelah, WA. Medium slash, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and torching. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

**Moon Complex** (2 fires), Rogue River-Siskiyou NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 5). Thirty-five miles northwest of Grants Pass, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and spotting. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Kelsey Peak**, Medford District, BLM. CIMT (ODF Team 1). Fourteen miles west of Glendale, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Wildcat**, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 10). Thirty miles west of Naches, WA. Timber, brush and closed timber litter. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, creeping and torching. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Tacoma Creek**, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (GB Team 7). Started on private land 15 miles northwest of Cusick, WA. Timber, light slash and brush. Moderate fire behavior with group torching, short-range spotting and backing. Structures, communication and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

**Emigrant**, Willamette NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 3). Twenty-four miles southeast of Oakridge, OR. Medium slash, timber and closed timber litter. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Bridge**, Malheur NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (CA Team 4) back to the local unit will occur tomorrow. Ten miles northeast of Prairie City, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Mark's Creek**, Ochoco NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (ODF Team 2) back to the local unit will occur today. Eighteen miles east of Prineville, OR. Timber. Minimal fire behavior. Energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Perry**, North Cascades NP, NPS. Sixteen miles northeast of Newhalem, WA. Timber and closed timber litter. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

**Tunnel Creek**, Olympic NF, USFS. Ten miles southwest of Quilcene, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, flanking and creeping. Trail closures in effect.

**Bear Gulch**, Olympic NF, USFS. Ten miles northwest of Hoodsport, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping, and smoldering. Residences threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Black Rock**, Prineville District, BLM. Thirteen miles west of Fossil, OR. Brush, timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with backing. Residences threatened. Evacuations in effect.

**Mccormach**, Mid-Columbia NWR, FWS. Five miles west of Umatilla, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

**Martin**, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Forty-five miles northwest of Chelan, WA. Timber and brush. No new information.

**Snow Peak**, Colville NF, USFS. Nineteen miles west of Kettle Falls, WA. Timber, closed timber litter. No new information. Last report unless new information is received.

**Deep Creek**, Prineville District, BLM. Twelve miles southwest of Maupin, OR. Grass and brush. No new information. Last report unless new information is received.

## **Predictive Services Discussion:**

Cool temperatures and higher RH will continue across the northern Intermountain West with drier and warmer weather in the Northwest and California. Showers and thunderstorms Friday morning are possible from the Southwest near the Divide north to the northern Rockies and in the northern Plains. Thunderstorms will weaken through midday before redeveloping in the afternoon with widespread wetter showers and thunderstorms from New Mexico, north across the central and northern Rockies, spreading into the northern Plains by the evening. Thunderstorms will remain scattered in the central and northern Great Basin and the northern Rockies west of the Divide. Thunderstorms in the Southwest, Rockies and northern Plains will continue overnight. Dry and breezy conditions will occur across northern Arizona and in local areas in the eastern Great Basin, but winds will be weaker than in previous days. The drying trend will continue in the Southeast with well above normal temperatures from the Plains to the Tennessee and Ohio Valleys, and near-record temperatures in the Mississippi Valley with an uptick in initial attack possible. Dry and breezy southerly winds are expected in west Texas and western Oklahoma into the central Plains. Scattered showers are expected in the northern Great Lakes ahead of a Canadian cold front. Scattered showers and thunderstorms will continue across the southern half of Florida and coastal Southeast.
