Jumping Branch, North Carolina Forest Service. Started on private land four miles northwest of Marion, NC. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with creeping. Residences threatened.

Box, Osage Agency, BIA. Seven miles south of Gray Horse, OK. Timber, grass and hardwood litter. Extreme fire behavior with crowning, wind-driven runs and long-range spotting. Residences threatened.

Thompson, Osage Agency, BIA. Five miles southwest of Bowring, OK. Timber, hardwood litter and grass. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, running and spotting.

River Ranch, Oklahoma DOF. Seven miles northeast of Proctor, OK. Timber. Minimal fire behavior. Structures threatened.

Slover Rd, Georgia Forestry Commission. Four miles southwest of Jesup, GA. Southern rough and timber. Moderate fire behavior with creeping and flanking.

Cane Creek, North Carolina Forest Service. Started on private land nine miles north of North Wilkesboro, NC. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

139, National Forests in Florida, USFS. One mile north of Wilma, FL. Southern rough. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and backing.

Mill Pond, National Forests in Florida, USFS. Three miles south of Telogia, FL. Southern rough and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Woodlawn, Francis Marion & Sumter NF, USFS. Six miles north of Evans, SC. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior.

Hall Thompson Lane, Alabama Forestry Commission. Nineteen miles north of Westover, AL. Brush. Minimal fire behavior.

* **Hurricane Branch 2**, Kentucky DOF. Started on private land five miles north of Elkhorn City, KY. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Lamar Bennett Trail, Georgia Forestry Commission. One mile west of Beach, GA. Southern rough and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Carroll – Cr 145, Mississippi Forestry Commission. Five miles northeast of Black Hawk, MS. Southern rough. No new information. Last narrative report unless new information is received.
