## **Predictive Services Discussion:**

Breezy southwest winds 15-25 mph with gusts to 35 mph amid relative humidity of 7-20% will develop across southern New Mexico to West Texas today creating elevated to locally critical conditions. Scattered showers and thunderstorms, some severe, will develop ahead of a cold front from the southern Plains into the Mid-Mississippi Valley, Lower Great Lakes, and southern New England. Very dry conditions will persist on the east slopes of the Appalachians into the Southeast with minimum relative humidity of 15-30%, and localized southwest winds 10-18 mph will create areas of elevated conditions. A cold front will move through the Northwest, northern California, and northern Rockies today with rain, and snow above 4,000 to 6,000 feet. Cold temperatures and occasional showers will continue across the southern two-thirds of Alaska, while sea breezes and scattered showers are expected in Hawai'i.
