STE Alum, Daniel Boone NF, USFS. Three miles west of Whitley City, KY. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with smoldering, flanking and creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Woodbury, South Carolina Forestry Commission. Ten miles east of Hemingway, SC. Southern rough and timber. Moderate fire behavior. Residences threatened.

Rosindale Road, North Carolina Forest Service. Eight miles north of Lake Waccamaw, NC. Southern rough. Moderate fire behavior with smoldering.
