**Appalachia**, Cherokee NF, USFS. Eight miles north of Ducktown, TN. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing and flanking. Railroad infrastructure threatened. Road and trail closures in effect.

**SR 26**, Florida Forest Service. Five miles east of Gainesville, FL. Southern rough. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Structures threatened. Road closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

\* **McGarrh**, Georgia Forestry Commission. Three miles west of Summertown, GA. Timber. Extreme fire behavior with running and crowning.

\* **Old Orangeburg**, South Carolina Forestry Commission. Five miles southwest of Estill, SC. Timber and southern rough. Active fire behavior with flanking.
