Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel from the 302nd Airlift Wing (Air Force Reserve, CO) have been deployed to Klamath Falls, OR. One MAFFS C-130 airtanker from the 153rd Airlift Wing (WY Air National Guard) and one MAFFS C-130 airtanker from the 146th Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard) and respective support personnel have been deployed to Redding, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally.

Modrite, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (NR Team 3). CIMT (NW Team 3) mobilizing. CIMT is also managing the Bradeen Hill incident. Seventeen miles southwest of Inchelium, WA. Timber and hardwood litter. Extreme fire behavior with crowning, uphill runs and short-range spotting. Area and road closures in effect.

Bradeen Hill, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Seventeen miles southwest of Colville, WA. Timber and hardwood litter. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and smoldering. Numerous residences threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Grasshopper, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 6). Three miles north of Sportsman Park, OR. Timber, hardwood litter and grass. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and uphill runs. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Second Flat, Burns District, BLM. CIMT (CA Team 4). CIMT is also managing the Coleman Creek incident. Six miles northeast of Riley, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, group torching and short-range spotting. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Coleman Creek, Burns District, BLM. Eight miles east of Juntura, OR. Grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, short-range spotting and running. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hat, Vale District, BLM. CIMT (CA Team 5). CIMT is also managing the Big Grass incident. Forty miles east of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Big Grass, Vale District, BLM. Twenty-five miles southwest of Jordan Valley, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with group torching and flanking. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Little Giant, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 2). CIMT is also managing the Dirty Face incident. Thirty miles northwest of Leavenworth, WA. Timber and brush. Extreme fire behavior with long-range spotting, uphill runs and crowning. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Dirty Face, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Thirty-eight miles northwest of Wenatchee, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior.

Rowe Creek Complex (2 fires), Prineville District, BLM. Transfer of command from CIMT (NW Team 2) to CIMT (SW Team 2) will occur tomorrow. CIMT (ODF Team 3). Ten miles south of Fossil, OR. Grass, timber and brush. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, single tree torching and short-range spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

0587 Shingle, Fossil Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (GB Team 5). Fourteen miles southeast of Mitchell, OR. Grass and timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Paradise, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 7). CIMT is also managing the Hagen and Horse Ridge incidents. Eighteen miles east of Milton-Freewater, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and torching. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hagen, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-six miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, torching and spotting. Numerous residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Horse Ridge, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-five miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Bench, Warm Springs Agency, BIA. CIMT (SW Team 4). Four miles south of Warm Springs, OR. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with short crown runs, group torching and long-range spotting. Numerous residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Powder River, Vale District, BLM. CIMT (SW Team 3). CIMT (CA Team 7) mobilizing. CIMT is also managing the Fox incident. Four miles southwest of Richland, OR. Grass, closed timber litter and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Evacuations in effect.

Fox, Vale District, BLM. Twelve miles northeast of Huntington, OR. Grass and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and short-range spotting. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Kaiser Canyon, Colville Agency, BIA. Transfer of command from CIMT (NR Team 2) to CIMT (AK Team 2) will occur tomorrow. One mile south of Nespelem, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and short-range spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

Castle, Umpqua NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 3). Twenty-three miles northeast of Tiller, OR. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, short-range spotting and uphill runs. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Anthony, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (NW Team 13) back to the local unit will occur tomorrow. CIMT is also managing the Burnt Creek incident. Thirty-four miles north of Baker City, OR. Closed timber litter and timber. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, backing and creeping. Residences threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Burnt Creek, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. Twenty-three miles north of Enterprise, OR. Timber and grass. Moderate fire behavior with spotting, isolated torching and running. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Jackass Butte, Burns District, BLM. Transfer of command from CIMT (SA Team 2) back to the local unit will occur today. CIMT is also managing the Bald Mountain, Stubble and Crater incidents. Forty miles south of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened.

Bald Mountain, Burns District, BLM. Fifty miles southeast of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, running and single tree torching. Numerous structures threatened.

Stubble, Malheur NWR, FWS. Fifteen miles southwest of Lawen, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened.

Crater, Burns District, BLM. Thirty-five miles south of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Structures threatened.

Akawa Butte, Sisters Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (ODF Team 2). Thirteen miles northeast of Sisters, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering, backing and creeping. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hay Creek Complex, Prineville District, BLM. Transfer of command from CIMT (NW Team 10) back to the local unit will occur today. Five miles west of Condon, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Area closures in effect.

Coyote, Ochoco NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 1). CIMT is also managing the Henry incident. Five miles south of Post, OR. Brush, timber and medium slash. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Henry, Prineville District, BLM. Five miles south of Paulina Guard Station, OR. Brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

E Evans Creek Rd, Medford Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (FL State Team 1). Fourteen miles northeast of Rogue River, OR. Closed timber litter, timber and medium slash. Minimal fire behavior with backing and smoldering. Communication infrastructure threatened.

Sinlahekin, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (Cal Fire Team 4). Twelve miles west of Tonasket, WA. Timber and grass. Extreme fire behavior with flanking, crowning and wind-driven runs. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Skyo, Gifford Pinchot NF, USFS. Three miles southwest of Packwood, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and single tree torching. Residences threatened. Evacuations and area closures in effect.

Salmon, Umatilla NF, USFS. Thirty-four miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Olive Butte, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. Thirty-four miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and light slash. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Ptarmigan, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Twenty miles northwest of Mazama, WA. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, wind-driven runs and backing. Structures threatened. Road and trail closures in effect.

Border 2, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Thirty-six miles northeast of Marblemount, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with group torching and flanking. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Ransier, Yakama Agency, BIA. Two miles south of White Swan, WA. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Luna, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Ten miles north of Newhalem, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with group torching and flanking. Structures threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

Egypt, Malheur NF, USFS. Twelve miles north of Riley, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior.

Bologna, Umatilla NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Kimberly, OR. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Area closures in effect.

Bob Creek, Vale District, BLM. One mile north of Oxbow, OR. Timber, brush and grass. No new information. Last narrative report unless new information is received.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Widespread critical to extreme conditions will develop across the Inland Northwest by late morning. These conditions are expected to worsen into the afternoon and evening while spreading eastward into the Northern Rockies and the far northern Great Basin. Unseasonably strong wind gusts of 35–50 mph are anticipated in many areas, with minimum RH 5–25%. Localized gusts of 60+ mph are likely over portions of northwest Montana tonight. Under these extreme conditions, many existing fires will display extreme growth, and new ignitions will be extremely resistant to control. Ahead of the strong cold front, a very large expanse of record or near-record heat will affect areas from inland California and the Southwest to the Great Basin and Northern Rockies, with some locations approaching monthly records for August. RH of 3–15% will return across inland California, the Great Basin, southwest Wyoming, and the West Slope. Moderate southwest winds may create elevated conditions in these areas for several hours. Pronounced drying is also expected in northern Arizona and the Four Corners, with minimum RH falling to 7–18%. Very isolated dry thunderstorms are possible for southwest Montana and north central Idaho into the Rockies with wet thunderstorms for central and eastern New Mexico. Cooler-than-average temperatures east of the Mississippi River Valley with areas of strong to severe thunderstorms from the Ohio River Valley to the Southeast.
