One 15-member incident management team and 59 fireline management personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest Area.

Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel from the 302nd Airlift Wing (Air Force Reserve, CO) have been deployed to Klamath Falls, OR. One MAFFS C-130 airtanker from the 153rd Airlift Wing (WY Air National Guard) and one MAFFS C-130 airtanker from the 146th Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard) and respective support personnel have been deployed to Redding, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally.

Modrite, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Transfer of command from CIMT (NR Team 3) to CIMT (NW Team 3) will occur tomorrow. CIMT is also managing the Bradeen Hill incident. Seventeen miles southwest of Inchelium, WA. Timber and hardwood litter. Extreme fire behavior with crowning, uphill runs and short-range spotting. Area and road closures in effect.

Bradeen Hill, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Seventeen miles southwest of Colville, WA. Timber and hardwood litter. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, single tree torching and short-range spotting. Numerous residences threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

* **Mitre Rock**, Spokane Agency, BIA. Nineteen miles northwest of Davenport, WA. Brush and grass. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs and spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations in effect.

* **Hudspeth**, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Three miles southeast of Hunters, WA. Timber. Extreme fire behavior. Residences threatened. Evacuations in effect.

* **Old Trails**, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (CA Team 7). CIMT is also managing the Autumn Lane and Fairview incidents. Three miles west of Spokane, WA. Timber and brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, crowning and short-range spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

* **Autumn Lane**, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Seven miles northwest of Spokane, WA. Timber and grass. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, spotting and torching. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

* **Fairview**, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Two miles northeast of Spokane, WA. Timber and grass. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, crowning and short-range spotting. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

Grasshopper, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 6). Three miles north of Sportsman Park, OR. Timber, hardwood litter and grass. Active fire behavior with backing, flanking and uphill runs. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Little Giant, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 2). CIMT is also managing the Dirty Face incident. Thirty miles northwest of Leavenworth, WA. Timber and brush. Extreme fire behavior with crowning, long-range spotting and uphill runs. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Dirty Face, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Thirty-eight miles northwest of Wenatchee, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior.

Second Flat, Burns District, BLM. CIMT (CA Team 4). CIMT is also managing the Coleman Creek incident. Six miles northeast of Riley, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, group torching and short-range spotting. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Coleman Creek, Burns District, BLM. Eight miles east of Juntura, OR. Grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, long-range spotting and running. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sinlahekin, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (Cal Fire Team 4). Twelve miles west of Tonasket, WA. Timber and grass. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, long-range spotting and single tree torching. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hat, Vale District, BLM. CIMT (CA Team 5). CIMT is also managing the Big Grass incident. Forty miles east of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Big Grass, Vale District, BLM. Twenty-five miles southwest of Jordan Valley, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with group torching and wind-driven runs. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Rowe Creek Complex (2 fires), Prineville District, BLM. Transfer of command from CIMT (NW Team 2) to CIMT (SW Team 2) will occur today. CIMT (ODF Team 3). Ten miles south of Fossil, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, torching and spotting. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

0587 Shingle, Fossil Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (GB Team 5). Fourteen miles southeast of Mitchell, OR. Grass and timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Paradise, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 7). CIMT (GB Team 2) mobilizing. CIMT is also managing the Hagen and Horse Ridge incidents. Eighteen miles east of Milton-Freewater, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, torching and spotting. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hagen, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-six miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, torching and spotting. Numerous residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Horse Ridge, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-five miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Kaiser Canyon, Colville Agency, BIA. Transfer of command from CIMT (NR Team 2) to CIMT (AK Team 2) will occur today. One mile south of Nespelem, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Extreme fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and short-range spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

Powder River, Vale District, BLM. CIMT (SW Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Fox and Bob Creek incidents. Four miles southwest of Richland, OR. Grass, closed timber litter and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Evacuations in effect.

Fox, Vale District, BLM. Twelve miles northeast of Huntington, OR. Grass and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and short-range spotting. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Bob Creek, Vale District, BLM. One mile north of Oxbow, OR. Grass, timber and closed timber litter. Moderate fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

Bench, Warm Springs Agency, BIA. CIMT (SW Team 4). Four miles south of Warm Springs, OR. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and group torching. Numerous residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Castle, Umpqua NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 3). Twenty-three miles northeast of Tiller, OR. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, backing and short-range spotting. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

E Evans Creek Rd, Medford Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (FL State Team 1). Fourteen miles northeast of Rogue River, OR. Closed timber litter, timber and medium slash. Minimal fire behavior with backing and smoldering. Communication infrastructure threatened.

Coyote, Ochoco NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 1). CIMT is also managing the Henry incident. Five miles south of Post, OR. Brush, timber and medium slash. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Henry, Prineville District, BLM. Five miles south of Paulina Guard Station, OR. Brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Ptarmigan, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Twenty miles northwest of Mazama, WA. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, wind-driven runs and running. Structures threatened. Road and trail closures in effect.

Skyo, Gifford Pinchot NF, USFS. Three miles southwest of Packwood, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and single tree torching. Residences threatened. Evacuations and area closures in effect.

Akawa Butte, Sisters Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (ODF Team 2). Thirteen miles northeast of Sisters, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Jackass Butte, Burns District, BLM. Transfer of command from CIMT (SA Team 2) back to the local unit will occur today. CIMT is also managing the Bald Mountain, Stubble and Crater incidents. Forty miles south of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened.

Bald Mountain, Burns District, BLM. Fifty miles southeast of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs and single tree torching. Numerous structures threatened. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Hay Creek Complex, Prineville District, BLM. Five miles west of Condon, OR. Grass and brush. Area closures in effect.

Salmon, Umatilla NF, USFS. Thirty-four miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Olive Butte, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. Thirty-four miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and light slash. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Border 2, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Thirty-six miles northeast of Marblemount, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with group torching and flanking. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Ransier, Yakama Agency, BIA. Two miles south of White Swan, WA. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Luna, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Ten miles north of Newhalem, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with group torching and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

Egypt, Malheur NF, USFS. Twelve miles north of Riley, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior.

Anthony, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (NW Team 13) back to the local unit will occur today. CIMT is also managing the Burnt Creek incident. Thirty-four miles north of Baker City, OR. Closed timber litter and timber. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, backing and creeping. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Burnt Creek, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. Twenty-three miles north of Enterprise, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with spotting, isolated torching and running. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

* **2908 Mccullough Rd**, Yakama Agency, BIA. One mile south of Union Gap, WA. Grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with uphill runs, wind-driven runs and running. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

Predictive Services Discussion:

8/2/2026 Critical conditions will persist across the northern Rockies, northern Great Basin, and northern Plains through this evening as a strong cold front shifts east and south. Westerly winds near and east of the Divide in Montana will reach 20-30 mph with gusts up to 50 mph amid 10-20% RH. Near and ahead of the front across most of the Great Basin to the central Rockies, expect west to southwest winds of 15-25 mph, gusts of 25-40 mph, and 4-12% RH. Despite cooler-than-normal temperatures, elevated conditions will also linger in the Inland Northwest, particularly southeast Oregon. Temperatures remain well above normal ahead of the front across the southern half of the West, Wyoming, and northern Plains, with highs near 100°F in the northern Plains and extreme temperatures of 100-120°F in the lower elevations of California, the central/southern Great Basin, and Southwest. Very low RH is expected across California, the Great Basin, northern Arizona, the Four Corners, and the West Slope. Southeast Arizona and southern New Mexico will see isolated to scattered wet thunderstorms. Meanwhile, areas east of the Mississippi River Valley, including the Southeast and most of Florida, will experience near to slightly below normal temperatures with widespread showers and thunderstorms.
