One 15-member incident management team and 59 fireline management personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest Area.

Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel from the 302nd Airlift Wing (Air Force Reserve, CO) have been deployed to Klamath Falls, OR. Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers from the 146th Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard) and respective support personnel have been deployed to Redding, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally.

Two hundred forty soldiers from the 1st Battalion, 23rd Infantry Regiment, 7th Infantry Division based out of Joint Base Lewis McChord (JBLM) are deployed in support of wildland fire operations on the Modrite fire. An Incident Management Organization (IMO) is assigned to support the military contingent.

Little Giant, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 12). Thirty miles northwest of Leavenworth, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and group torching. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grasshopper, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. CIMT (SA Team 2). CIMT is also managing the Austin incident. Ten miles east of Government Camp, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with running, flanking and wind-driven runs. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Austin, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Twenty-five miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with running, single tree torching and spotting. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Paradise, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 6). CIMT is also managing the Hagen incident. Eighteen miles east of Milton-Freewater, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with running, torching and spotting. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hagen, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-six miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with running, torching and spotting. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Three Queens, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 13). CIMT is also managing the Grand Park 2 incident. Six miles east of Snoqualmie Pass, WA. Timber and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, group torching and short-range spotting. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grand Park 2, Mount Rainier National Park, NPS. Seven miles southwest of Snoquera, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and grass. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Rowe Creek Complex (2 fires), Prineville District, BLM. Transfer of command from CIMT (SW Team 2) to CIMT (ODF Team 2) will occur tomorrow. Ten miles south of Fossil, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and single tree torching. Numerous residences and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Big Grass, Vale District, BLM. CIMT (NW Team 10). Twenty-five miles southwest of Jordan Valley, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area and trail closures in effect.

Wrights Spring, Fremont-Winema NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 8). Two miles west of Sprague River, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with crowning, running and spotting. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

Bologna, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (ODF Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Cottonwood and Little Bear incidents. Seven miles northeast of Kimberly, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Cottonwood, John Day Unit, Oregon DOF. Fifteen miles southwest of Long Creek, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Road and trail closures in effect.

* **Little Bear**, John Day Unit, Oregon DOF. Eight miles northeast of Mt. Vernon, OR. Timber and light slash. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sinlahekin, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Transfer of command from CIMT (Cal Fire Team 4) to CIMT (Cal Fire Team 5) will occur tomorrow. One mile west of Tonasket, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Kaiser Canyon, Colville Agency, BIA. Transfer of command from CIMT (AK Team 2) to CIMT (NW Team 2) will occur tomorrow. One mile south of Nespelem, WA. Grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, creeping and short-range spotting. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Modrite, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (NW Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Bradeen Hill and Hudspeth incidents. Seventeen miles southwest of Inchelium, WA. Timber and hardwood litter. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Numerous residences threatened. Area and road closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Bradeen Hill, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Seventeen miles southwest of Colville, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations and area closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Hudspeth, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Three miles southeast of Hunters, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Ptarmigan, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. NIMO Team 3. Twenty miles northwest of Mazama, WA. Timber, medium slash and brush. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and torching. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Old Trails, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (CA Team 7). CIMT is also managing the Autumn Lane and Fairview incidents. Three miles west of Spokane, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Autumn Lane, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Seven miles northwest of Spokane, WA. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Fairview, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Two miles northeast of Spokane, WA. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Second Flat, Burns District, BLM. Transfer of command from CIMT (CA Team 4) back to the local unit will occur today. CIMT is also managing the Coleman Creek and Bald Mountain incidents. Six miles northeast of Riley, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Coleman Creek, Burns District, BLM. Eight miles east of Juntura, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Bald Mountain, Burns District, BLM. Fifty miles southeast of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

0587 Shingle, Fossil Unit, Oregon DOF. Fourteen miles southeast of Mitchell, OR. Grass and timber. Moderate fire behavior with uphill runs, creeping and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Coyote, Ochoco NF, USFS. Five miles south of Post, OR. Brush, timber and medium slash. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

High Lava, Gifford Pinchot NF, USFS. Eleven miles northwest of Stabler, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Luna, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Ten miles north of Newhalem, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and group torching. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

Castle, Umpqua NF, USFS. Twenty-three miles northeast of Tiller, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Border 2, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Thirty-six miles northeast of Marblemount, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with backing, flanking and single tree torching. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Prairie Mountain, Northwest Region, Washington DNR. Seven miles northeast of Darrington, WA. Heavy slash and timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Area and road closures in effect.

Alpowa, Washington State Fire Marshal's Office. Eight miles west of Clarkston, WA. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Eggo, Wallowa Unit, Oregon DOF. Seventeen miles northeast of Enterprise, OR. Grass and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Fox, Vale District, BLM. Twelve miles northeast of Huntington, OR. Grass, brush and timber. No new information.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Southerly winds up to 35 mph, unrelenting extreme heat, and 15-30% RH will create elevated to locally critical fire conditions in the southern Plains afternoon. Very hot, dry, and moderately breezy conditions will expand across the Lower Mississippi River Valley, northern Gulf Coast, Florida, and the southeast Atlantic coast. Isolated mixed wet/dry thunderstorms are possible in the High Plains, including the Texas and Oklahoma panhandles. Highest confidence in dry lightning is expected from northwest California and the southern Cascades east across Oregon into far western Idaho. Isolated to scattered mixed wet/dry thunderstorms will impact the rest of the Northwest, northern California, northwest Nevada, Idaho, and far western Montana. Wetter thunderstorms will be scattered in the central/southern Great Basin, western Montana, much of Wyoming, Colorado, and the Southwest. RH will continue to slowly moderate in the West (minima 15-35% for most areas) with near or below-normal temperatures. Alaska's eastern Interior will remain very warm and mostly dry with isolated thunderstorms. Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands continue to experience high-risk significant fire potential due to very warm, dry conditions and stronger winds the next two days.
