Three 15-member incident management teams and 196 fireline management personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest and Great Basin geographic areas.

Two Large Airtankers and one Birdog from Manitoba, Canada have been deployed to Boise, ID in support of wildland fire operations.

Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel from the 302nd Airlift Wing (Air Force Reserve, CO) have been deployed to Klamath Falls, OR. Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers from the 146th Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard) and respective support personnel have been deployed to Redding, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally.

Two hundred forty soldiers from the 1st Battalion, 23rd Infantry Regiment, 7th Infantry Division based out of Joint Base Lewis McChord (JBLM) are deployed in support of wildland fire operations on the Modrite fire. An Incident Management Organization (IMO) is assigned to support the military contingent.

Fielder Mtn, Grants Pass Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (ODF Team 1). One mile west of Rogue River, OR. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, spotting and torching. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

Little Giant, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 12). Thirty miles northwest of Leavenworth, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and torching. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grasshopper, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. CIMT (SA Team 2). CIMT is also managing the Austin incident. Ten miles east of Government Camp, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with running, flanking and wind-driven runs. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Austin, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Twenty-five miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with running, single tree torching and spotting. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Paradise, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 6). CIMT is also managing the Hagen incident. Eighteen miles east of Milton-Freewater, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with running, torching and spotting. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hagen, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-six miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with running, torching and spotting. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Three Queens, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 13). CIMT is also managing the Grand Park 2 incident. Six miles east of Snoqualmie Pass, WA. Timber and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, short-range spotting and group torching. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Grand Park 2, Mount Rainier National Park, NPS. Seven miles southwest of Snoquera, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and grass. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wrights Spring, Fremont-Winema NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 8). Two miles west of Sprague River, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Moderate fire behavior with running, isolated torching and spotting. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Rowe Creek Complex (2 fires), Prineville District, BLM. Transfer of command from CIMT (SW Team 2) to CIMT (ODF Team 2) will occur today. Ten miles south of Fossil, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous residences and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Big Grass, Vale District, BLM. CIMT (NW Team 10). Twenty-five miles southwest of Jordan Valley, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with flanking, torching and creeping. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area and trail closures in effect.

Kaiser Canyon, Colville Agency, BIA. Transfer of command from CIMT (AK Team 2) to CIMT (NW Team 2) will occur today. CIMT is also managing the Modrite incident. One mile south of Nespelem, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, creeping and short-range spotting. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

Modrite, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Seventeen miles southwest of Inchelium, WA. Timber and hardwood litter. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

Bologna, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (ODF Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Cottonwood, Little Bear and Rosenbaum incidents. Seven miles northeast of Kimberly, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Cottonwood, John Day Unit, Oregon DOF. Fifteen miles southwest of Long Creek, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering.

Little Bear, John Day Unit, Oregon DOF. Eight miles northeast of Mt. Vernon, OR. Timber and light slash. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering.

* **Rosenbaum**, Fossil Unit, Oregon DOF. Ten miles northwest of Spray, OR. Timber and brush. Extreme fire behavior with uphill runs, torching and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Road closures in effect.

Sinlahekin, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Transfer of command from CIMT (Cal Fire Team 4) to CIMT (Cal Fire Team 5) will occur today. One mile west of Tonasket, WA. Timber, brush and light slash. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Bradeen Hill, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Seventeen miles southwest of Colville, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Evacuations in effect.

Hudspeth, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Three miles southeast of Hunters, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations in effect.

Ptarmigan, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. NIMO Team 3. Twenty miles northwest of Mazama, WA. Timber, heavy slash and brush. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and torching. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Old Trails, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Transfer of command from CIMT (CA Team 7) back to the local unit will occur tomorrow. CIMT is also managing the Autumn Lane and Fairview incidents. Three miles west of Spokane, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Autumn Lane, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Seven miles northwest of Spokane, WA. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Fairview, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Two miles northeast of Spokane, WA. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

0587 Shingle, Fossil Unit, Oregon DOF. Fourteen miles southeast of Mitchell, OR. Grass and timber. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, smoldering and flanking. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

High Lava, Gifford Pinchot NF, USFS. Eleven miles northwest of Stabler, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Luna, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Ten miles north of Newhalem, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, single tree torching and spotting. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

Border 2, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Thirty-six miles northeast of Marblemount, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with backing, flanking and creeping. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Prairie Mountain, Northwest Region, Washington DNR. Seven miles northeast of Darrington, WA. Heavy slash and timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Area and road closures in effect.

Second Flat, Burns District, BLM. Six miles northeast of Riley, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

E Evans Creek Rd, Medford Unit, Oregon DOF. Fourteen miles northeast of Rogue River, OR. Closed timber litter, timber and medium slash. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Fox, Vale District, BLM. Twelve miles northeast of Huntington, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Egypt, Malheur NF, USFS. Twelve miles north of Riley, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior.

Coleman Creek, Burns District, BLM. Eight miles east of Juntura, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Bald Mountain, Burns District, BLM. Fifty miles southeast of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Coyote, Ochoco NF, USFS. Five miles south of Post, OR. Brush, timber and medium slash. No new information.

Castle, Umpqua NF, USFS. Twenty-three miles northeast of Tiller, OR. Grass and brush. No new information.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Another very hot, dry and windy day is expected to occur over the Southern Plains from eastern Kansas and western Missouri south through Oklahoma into much of Texas. Critical fire weather conditions are anticipated due to high temperatures in the upper 90s to lower 100s with southerly wind gusts of 20-30 mph and relative humidity values ranging from 25-35%. Farther west the monsoon moisture combined with a weak disturbance, tracking northeast off the northern California Coast will trigger additional thunderstorms. The most numerous storms will impact extreme southeast Washington, eastern Oregon and the southern half of Idaho. Isolated thunderstorms will also be possible over the Washington and northern Oregon Cascades and much of the Rockies. The other location which will see a high risk of fire weather concerns will occur over Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands where gusty winds will combine with low relative humidity values and very dry fuels. The last area of concern will be Hawaii due to the approach of Hurricane Lala which will deliver copious amounts of rainfall bringing severe flooding and mudslides especially on the Big Island.
