Three 15-member incident management teams and 270 fireline management personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest and Great Basin geographic areas.

Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers from the 302nd Airlift Wing (Air Force Reserve, CO) and one from the 152nd Airlift Wing (NV Air National Guard), with respective support personnel, have been deployed to Klamath Falls, OR. Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel from the 146th Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard) have been deployed to Redding, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally.

Two hundred forty soldiers from the 1st Battalion, 23rd Infantry Regiment, 7th Infantry Division based out of Joint Base Lewis McChord (JBLM) are deployed in support of wildland fire operations on the Little Giant fire. An Incident Management Organization (IMO) is assigned to support the military contingent.

Little Giant, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 12). CIMT (CA Team 5) mobilizing. CIMT is also managing the Sisi incident. Thirty miles northwest of Leavenworth, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, group torching and spotting. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

* **Sisi**, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Ten miles northwest of Stehekin, WA. Closed timber litter, timber and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, group torching and spotting.

Paradise, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (SA Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Hagen incident. Eighteen miles east of Milton-Freewater, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hagen, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-six miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Three Queens, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 13). CIMT is also managing the Grand Park 2 incident. Six miles east of Snoqualmie Pass, WA. Timber and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with backing, flanking and torching. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grand Park 2, Mount Rainier National Park, NPS. Seven miles southwest of Snoquera, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and grass. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, smoldering and backing. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grasshopper, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. CIMT (SA Team 2). CIMT is also managing the Austin and The Narrows incidents. Fourteen miles southwest of Dufur, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and group torching. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Austin, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Twenty-five miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, uphill runs and isolated torching. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

The Narrows, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Fifteen miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Timber. Active fire behavior with creeping, short-range spotting and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sinlahekin, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (Cal Fire Team 5). One mile west of Tonasket, WA. Timber, brush and light slash. Moderate fire behavior with backing, spotting and isolated torching. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wrights Spring, Fremont-Winema NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (NW Team 8) to CIMT (NW Team 7) will occur today. Two miles west of Sprague River, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, isolated torching and spotting. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

Rowe Creek Complex (2 fires), Prineville District, BLM. CIMT (ODF Team 2). Ten miles south of Fossil, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous residences and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Big Grass, Vale District, BLM. CIMT (NW Team 10). Twenty-five miles southwest of Jordan Valley, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, torching and smoldering. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Kaiser Canyon, Colville Agency, BIA. CIMT (NW Team 2). CIMT is also managing the Modrite incident. One mile south of Nespelem, WA. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with smoldering, creeping and backing. Residences threatened. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Modrite, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Seventeen miles southwest of Inchelium, WA. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering.

Fielder Mtn, Grants Pass Unit, Oregon DOF. Transfer of command from CIMT (ODF Team 1) back to the local unit will occur today. One mile west of Rogue River, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Critical infrastructure threatened.

Bologna, Umatilla NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (ODF Team 3) back to the local unit will occur today. CIMT is also managing the Little Bear, Rosenbaum and Cottonwood incidents. Seven miles northeast of Kimberly, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Little Bear, John Day Unit, Oregon DOF. Eight miles northeast of Mt. Vernon, OR. Timber and light slash. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Rosenbaum, Fossil Unit, Oregon DOF. Ten miles northwest of Spray, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Cottonwood, John Day Unit, Oregon DOF. Fifteen miles southwest of Long Creek, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

High Lava, Gifford Pinchot NF, USFS. Eleven miles northwest of Stabler, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Luna, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Ten miles north of Newhalem, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

Border 2, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Thirty-six miles northeast of Marblemount, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and group torching. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

* **Balky Hill**, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Five miles east of Twisp, WA. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with backing, flanking and torching.

Ptarmigan, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Twenty miles northwest of Mazama, WA. Timber, heavy slash and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and torching. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Picture Rock, Lakeview District, BLM. Three miles north of Summer Lake, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with single tree torching, smoldering and creeping. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened.

0587 Shingle, Fossil Unit, Oregon DOF. Fourteen miles southeast of Mitchell, OR. Grass and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering, creeping and single tree torching. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Second Flat, Burns District, BLM. Six miles northeast of Riley, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

E Evans Creek Rd, Medford Unit, Oregon DOF. Fourteen miles northeast of Rogue River, OR. Closed timber litter, timber and medium slash. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Egypt, Malheur NF, USFS. Twelve miles north of Riley, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior.

Windmill, Stillwater County. Nine miles north of Reed Point, MT. Brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with wind-driven runs, short crown runs and single tree torching. Structures threatened.

Sand Creek, Beaverhead-Deerlodge NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Bobcat Lakes incident. Five miles east of Wisdom, MT. Timber, brush and grass. Predictive Services Discussion:

High pressure will continue to amplify over the Western US today, bringing drying and warming conditions to the area, particularly across inland parts of the Pacific Northwest where temperatures are expected to be 10 to 15 degrees above normal. Highs in the 90's and lower 100's are forecast across the western half of the country, possibly reaching the lower 110's over southeast California and western Arizona. The hot temperatures will coincide with relative humidity levels in the single digits and teens in the afternoon and only poor recoveries expected at night. Conditions won't be quite as dry over the Desert Southwest where lingering monsoonal moisture will result in scattered afternoon thunderstorms. Gusty winds are expected in the afternoon throughout the Great Basin and into southeast Oregon, as well as near thunderstorms. Farther east, the main weather concern will revolve around the unwavering heat across the Southern Plains and Southeast. High temperatures in this area will peak in the 90s to 110F with relative humidity values dropping into the mid-teens to mid 20s. No strong winds are expected in these areas; however, wind gusts of 15-25 mph will be possible over Texas by afternoon. Numerous thunderstorms are also expected across the southeast and this could produce erratic outflow winds and new fire starts over the extremely dry and receptive fuels.
