Three 15-member incident management teams and 270 fireline management personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest and Great Basin geographic areas.

Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers from the 302nd Airlift Wing (Air Force Reserve, CO) and one from the 152nd Airlift Wing (NV Air National Guard), with respective support personnel, have been deployed to Klamath Falls, OR. Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel from the 146th Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard) have been deployed to Redding, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally.

Two hundred forty soldiers from the 1st Battalion, 23rd Infantry Regiment, 7th Infantry Division based out of Joint Base Lewis McChord (JBLM) are deployed in support of wildland fire operations on the Little Giant fire. An Incident Management Organization (IMO) is assigned to support the military contingent.

Little Giant, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 5). CIMT is also managing the Sisi incident. Thirty miles northwest of Leavenworth, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, group torching and spotting. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sisi, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Ten miles northwest of Stehekin, WA. Closed timber litter, timber and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, torching and flanking. Energy infrastructure threatened.

Paradise, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (SA Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Hagen incident. Eighteen miles east of Milton-Freewater, OR. Timber, heavy slash and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hagen, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-six miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and single tree torching. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Three Queens, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 13). CIMT is also managing the Grand Park 2, King and Goat incidents. Six miles east of Snoqualmie Pass, WA. Timber and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with group torching, flanking and backing. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grand Park 2, Mount Rainier National Park, NPS. Seven miles southwest of Snoquera, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and grass. Moderate fire behavior with backing, flanking and creeping. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

King, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Snoqualmie Pass, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Active fire behavior with group torching, spotting and uphill runs. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

* **Goat**, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Fifteen miles north of Ronald, WA. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with group torching, flanking and uphill runs. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Austin, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (SA Team 2) to CIMT (GB Team 4) will occur today. CIMT is also managing the Grasshopper and The Narrows incidents. Twenty-five miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, uphill runs and isolated torching. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grasshopper, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Fourteen miles southwest of Dufur, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and group torching. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

The Narrows, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Fifteen miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Brush. Active fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sinlahekin, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (Cal Fire Team 5). One mile west of Tonasket, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and single tree torching. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wrights Spring, Fremont-Winema NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 7). Two miles west of Sprague River, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, isolated torching and short-range spotting. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Rowe Creek Complex (2 fires), Prineville District, BLM. CIMT (ODF Team 2). Ten miles south of Fossil, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Kaiser Canyon, Colville Agency, BIA. Transfer of command from CIMT (NW Team 2) back to the local unit will occur tomorrow. CIMT is also managing the Modrite incident. One mile south of Nespelem, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering, creeping and backing. Residences threatened.

Modrite, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Seventeen miles southwest of Inchelium, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, backing and smoldering.

Big Grass, Vale District, BLM. Transfer of command from CIMT (NW Team 10) back to the local unit will occur today. Twenty-five miles southwest of Jordan Valley, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, torching and smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area and trail closures in effect.

* **McCulley**, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 3) mobilizing. CIMT is also managing the North Pole incident. Twenty-two miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and grass. Extreme fire behavior with uphill runs, crowning and spotting. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations in effect.

North Pole, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. Eighteen miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and grass. Extreme fire behavior with crowning, uphill runs and spotting. Structures threatened. Evacuations in effect.

Colwash, Yakama Agency, BIA. Five miles west of Mabton, WA. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with running, smoldering and backing. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

High Lava, Gifford Pinchot NF, USFS. Eleven miles northwest of Stabler, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Luna, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Ten miles north of Newhalem, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, flanking and single tree torching. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

Border 2, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Thirty-six miles northeast of Marblemount, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, flanking and single tree torching. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Ptarmigan, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Twenty miles northwest of Mazama, WA. Timber, heavy slash and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and torching. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Picture Rock, Lakeview District, BLM. Three miles north of Summer Lake, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Energy infrastructure threatened.

Fielder Mtn, Grants Pass Unit, Oregon DOF. One mile west of Rogue River, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior.

0587 Shingle, Fossil Unit, Oregon DOF. Fourteen miles southeast of Mitchell, OR. Grass and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Egypt, Malheur NF, USFS. Twelve miles north of Riley, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior.

Second Flat, Burns District, BLM. Six miles northeast of Riley, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Predictive Services Discussion:

A cold front will move through the northern Plains, with cooler temperatures expected today across much of Montana. However, the cooler temperatures observed in the Northwest yesterday will warm back above normal today with highs 80-95°F and minimum relative humidity will fall to 8-20%. Above normal temperatures will continue across the rest of the West, with isolated mixed wet and dry thunderstorms expected to develop across far northeast California and southeast Oregon into the northern Great Basin. Meanwhile, isolated to scattered monsoon thunderstorms will continue in Arizona, Utah, Colorado, and northwest New Mexico, although rainfall footprints will remain small due to the hot temperatures. Very hot temperatures of 100-110°F will continue across southern Oklahoma and much of north Texas amid relative humidity of 10-20%, and locally breezy winds will create elevated conditions. Isolated thunderstorms will develop across portions of the Lower Mississippi Valley amid above normal temperatures as well as the Florida Peninsula. In the Southeast, dry northwesterly winds around 10 mph will result in lower-than-average relative humidity of 25-35%. Rain and winds will ease in Hawai'i as Tropical Storm Moke moves westward away from the islands. Alaska will remain cool and damp except for the southeast Interior which will be warmer and drier today.
