Two 15-member incident management teams and 212 fireline personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest and Great Basin geographic areas.

Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers from the 302nd Airlift Wing (Air Force Reserve, CO) and one from the 152nd Airlift Wing (NV Air National Guard), with respective support personnel, have been deployed to Klamath Falls, OR. Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel from the 146th Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard) have been deployed to Redding, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally.

Two hundred forty soldiers from the 1st Battalion, 23rd Infantry Regiment, 7th Infantry Division based out of Joint Base Lewis McChord (JBLM) are deployed in support of wildland fire operations on the Little Giant fire. An Incident Management Organization (IMO) is assigned to support the military contingent.

McCully, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 3). CIMT is also managing the North Pole incident. Twenty-two miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and grass. Extreme fire behavior with short crown runs, torching and spotting. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Little Giant, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 5). CIMT is also managing the Sisi incident. Thirty miles northwest of Leavenworth, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and group torching. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sisi, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Ten miles northwest of Stehekin, WA. Closed timber litter, timber and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking and group torching. Energy infrastructure threatened. Trail closures in effect.

Three Queens, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (NW Team 13) to CIMT (NR Team 2) will occur tomorrow. CIMT is also managing the Grand Park 2, King, Goat and Wonderland Complex incidents. Six miles east of Snoqualmie Pass, WA. Timber and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with group torching, flanking and backing. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grand Park 2, Mount Rainier National Park, NPS. Twenty miles southeast of Buckley, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and grass. Moderate fire behavior with backing, flanking and isolated torching. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

King, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Snoqualmie Pass, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Active fire behavior with group torching and spotting. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Goat, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Fifteen miles north of Ronald, WA. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with group torching, flanking and uphill runs. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wonderland Complex, Mount Rainier National Park, NPS. Twenty miles southeast of Buckley, WA. Timber and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with flanking, group torching and backing. Energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Paradise, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (SA Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Hagen incident. Eighteen miles east of Milton-Freewater, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and spotting. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hagen, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-six miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Austin, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 4). CIMT is also managing the Grasshopper and The Narrows incidents. Twenty-five miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Timber. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, short-range spotting and single tree torching. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grasshopper, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Fourteen miles southwest of Dufur, OR. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with spotting, isolated torching and creeping. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

The Narrows, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Fifteen miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Brush, grass and light slash. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sinlahekin, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (Cal Fire Team 5). One mile west of Tonasket, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, group torching and backing. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wrights Spring, Fremont-Winema NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 7). Two miles west of Sprague River, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, isolated torching and short-range spotting. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

* **Mustang**, Vale District, BLM. Thirty miles southwest of Jordan Valley, OR. Grass and timber. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, running and flanking. Residences threatened.

* **Mitchell Springs**, Vale District, BLM. Five miles northwest of McDermitt, NV. Brush and grass. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, flanking and backing. Residences threatened.

Rowe Creek Complex (2 fires), Prineville District, BLM. CIMT (ODF Team 2). CIMT (CA Team 4) mobilizing. Ten miles south of Fossil, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Luna, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Ten miles north of Newhalem, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Structures threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

High Lava, Gifford Pinchot NF, USFS. Eleven miles northwest of Stabler, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Colwash, Yakama Agency, BIA. Five miles west of Mabton, WA. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Big Grass, Vale District, BLM. Twenty-five miles southwest of Jordan Valley, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with running, flanking and wind-driven runs. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area and trail closures in effect.

Kaiser Canyon, Colville Agency, BIA. One mile south of Nespelem, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering, creeping and backing. Residences threatened.

Border 2, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Thirty-six miles northeast of Marblemount, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Ptarmigan, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Twenty miles northwest of Mazama, WA. Timber, heavy slash and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and torching. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Picture Rock, Lakeview District, BLM. Three miles north of Summer Lake, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping.

Modrite, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Seventeen miles southwest of Inchelium, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering.

Egypt, Malheur NF, USFS. Twelve miles north of Riley, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior.

0587 Shingle, Fossil Unit, Oregon DOF. Fourteen miles southeast of Mitchell, OR. Grass and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

North Pole, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. Eighteen miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and grass. No new information.

Fielder Mtn, Grants Pass Unit, Oregon DOF. One mile west of Rogue River, OR. Timber, brush and grass. No new information. Last narrative report unless new information is received.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Isolated to scattered mixed wet/dry thunderstorms are expected from Idaho into western Montana and the northern Great Basin, bringing high-risk significant fire potential to those parts. Breezy westerly winds with gusts 25-35mph amid RH 10-20% and temperatures broadly 10-15°F above normal will develop across the northern half of the West away from the coast, bringing further high-risk significant fire potential to the northern Great Basing, inland Pacific Northwest, and the Sierra Front. In the Greater Four Corners, meager moisture will yield hot temperatures, minimum RH of 10-25%, and isolated mixed wet/dry thunderstorms. Overall moderate fire potential is increasing across this region and inland southern California as the monsoon wanes and overnight RH recovery trends downward. Across the southern Plains, very hot, dry and breezy conditions will continue across east Texas into Louisiana, resulting in a critical conditions. Moderate significant fire potential will persist across remaining parts of the south including southern Florida.
