Two 15-member incident management teams and 212 fireline personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest and Great Basin geographic areas.

Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers from the 302nd Airlift Wing (Air Force Reserve, CO) and one from the 152nd Airlift Wing (NV Air National Guard), with respective support personnel, have been deployed to Klamath Falls, OR. Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel from the 146th Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard) have been deployed to Redding, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally.

Two hundred forty soldiers from the 1st Battalion, 23rd Infantry Regiment, 7th Infantry Division based out of Joint Base Lewis McChord (JBLM) are deployed in support of wildland fire operations on the Little Giant fire. An Incident Management Organization (IMO) is assigned to support the military contingent.

Little Giant, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 5). CIMT is also managing the Sisi incident. Thirty miles northwest of Leavenworth, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and dormant brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and group torching. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sisi, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Ten miles northwest of Stehekin, WA. Closed timber litter and timber. Active fire behavior with short-range spotting, group torching and uphill runs. Energy infrastructure threatened. Trail closures in effect.

Three Queens, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (NW Team 13) to CIMT (NR Team 2) will occur today. CIMT is also managing the Grand Park 2, King, Goat and Wonderland Complex incidents. Six miles east of Snoqualmie Pass, WA. Timber and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with group torching, flanking and backing. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grand Park 2, Mount Rainier National Park, NPS. Seven miles southwest of Snoquera, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and grass. Moderate fire behavior with backing, flanking and isolated torching. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

King, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Snoqualmie Pass, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Active fire behavior with group torching, spotting and uphill runs. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Goat, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Fifteen miles north of Ronald, WA. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with group torching, flanking and uphill runs. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wonderland Complex, Mount Rainier National Park, NPS. Nine miles southeast of Snoquera, WA. Timber and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with flanking, uphill runs and backing. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

McCully, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 3). CIMT is also managing the North Pole incident. Twenty-two miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, torching and spotting. Numerous residences and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Paradise, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (SA Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Hagen incident. Eighteen miles east of Milton-Freewater, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and single tree torching. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hagen, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-six miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Austin, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 4). CIMT is also managing the Grasshopper and The Narrows incidents. Twenty-five miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, backing and single tree torching. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grasshopper, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Fourteen miles southwest of Dufur, OR. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, spotting and creeping. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

The Narrows, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Fifteen miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Brush, grass and light slash. Minimal fire behavior with flanking, creeping and smoldering. Critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sinlahekin, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (Cal Fire Team 5). CIMT (SW Team 3) mobilizing. One mile west of Tonasket, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Extreme fire behavior with crowning, uphill runs and long-range spotting. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Rowe Creek Complex (2 fires), Prineville District, BLM. Transfer of command from CIMT (ODF Team 2) to CIMT (CA Team 4) will occur tomorrow. Ten miles south of Fossil, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Wrights Spring, Fremont-Winema NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 7). Two miles west of Sprague River, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, isolated torching and smoldering. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Luna, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Ten miles north of Newhalem, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, isolated torching and backing. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

High Lava, Gifford Pinchot NF, USFS. Eleven miles northwest of Stabler, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, creeping and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Big Grass, Vale District, BLM. Twenty-five miles southwest of Jordan Valley, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with running, flanking and wind-driven runs. Numerous structures threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

Colwash, Yakama Agency, BIA. Five miles west of Mabton, WA. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Kaiser Canyon, Colville Agency, BIA. One mile south of Nespelem, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, smoldering and backing. Residences threatened.

Border 2, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Thirty-six miles northeast of Marblemount, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, flanking and isolated torching. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

* **Electric**, Mt. Baker-Snoqualmie NF, USFS. Seven miles north of Marblemount, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, backing and flanking. Road and trail closures in effect.

Mustang, Vale District, BLM. Thirty miles southwest of Jordan Valley, OR. Grass and timber. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, running and flanking.

Mitchell Springs, Vale District, BLM. Five miles northwest of McDermitt, NV. Brush and grass. Extreme fire behavior with uphill runs, running and flanking. Residences threatened.

Ptarmigan, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Twenty miles northwest of Mazama, WA. Timber, heavy slash and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and torching. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Picture Rock, Lakeview District, BLM. Three miles north of Summer Lake, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Energy infrastructure threatened.

Egypt, Malheur NF, USFS. Twelve miles north of Riley, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior.

Rosenbaum, Fossil Unit, Oregon DOF. Ten miles northwest of Spray, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior.

Modrite, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Seventeen miles southwest of Inchelium, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

North Pole, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. Eighteen miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and grass. No new information. Last narrative report unless new information is received.

Oxley, Elko District, BLM. Five miles north of Wells, NV. Brush, grass and timber. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, creeping and smoldering. Residences and communication infrastructure threatened.

Crooked, Boise NF, USFS. Fifteen miles east of Idaho City, ID. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with torching and flanking. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Forleen, Elko District, BLM. Twenty-three miles north of Wells, NV. Brush, grass and dormant brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Structures threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Kearny, White Pine County Fire Protection District. Thirty-seven miles north of Ely, NV. Timber, brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, creeping and smoldering. Energy infrastructure threatened.

California Creek, Humboldt-Toiyabe NF, USFS. One mile southeast of Mountain City, NV. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Energy infrastructure threatened. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Sombrero, Winnemucca District, BLM. Twenty-five miles northwest of Winnemucca, NV. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened.

Hawk, Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District. CIMT (GB Team 6). Five miles north of Reno, NV. Grass, timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering, creeping and isolated torching. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Slough Canyon, Uintah and Ouray Agency, BIA. Forty-one miles east of Price, UT. Timber, brush and grass. Active fire behavior with running, torching and spotting. Structures threatened.

Black Canyon, Manti-La Sal NF, USFS. Twenty-nine miles southwest of Price, UT. Timber, brush and medium slash. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wildhorse, Twin Falls District, BLM. Ten miles north of Kimama, ID. Grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, running and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Road closures in effect.

Flint, Boise District, BLM. Forty-five miles southwest of Nampa, ID. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with running, flanking and wind-driven runs. Residences threatened.

* **Calico**, Humboldt-Toiyabe NF, USFS. Twenty miles southwest of McDermitt, NV. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with running and wind-driven runs. Residences threatened.

Tom Creek, West Desert District, BLM. Ten miles south of Dugway, UT. Chaparral, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with torching, uphill runs and backing.

Bull Run, Elko County Fire Protection District. Twenty-five miles northeast of Tuscarora, NV. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Breezy west-southwest winds with gusts of 35–45 mph and RH of 5–20% will create elevated fire conditions across the Inland Northwest, northern Rockies, and northern Great Basin. Locally critical conditions are possible from northeast California and northwest Nevada into southeast Oregon and southwest Idaho. Scattered mixed wet/dry thunderstorms are expected across western Montana, central/eastern Idaho, and the central Rockies, with drier storms possible in northeast Washington and north Idaho. Isolated mixed wet/dry thunderstorms will also extend from the eastern Sierra through the Great Basin to the West Slope, while wetter storms remain more numerous in Colorado and New Mexico east of the Divide, and the western High Plains. Thunderstorms are expected from south Texas to the Southeast ahead of a slow-moving cold front, with thunderstorm activity increasing into the Mid-Atlantic and portions of the Northeast. Dry, seasonable weather will prevail across the Midwest and Great Lakes.
