Two 15-member incident management teams and 212 fireline personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest and Great Basin geographic areas.

Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers from the 302nd Airlift Wing (Air Force Reserve, CO) and one from the 152nd Airlift Wing (NV Air National Guard), with respective support personnel, have been deployed to Klamath Falls, OR. Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel from the 146th Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard) have been deployed to Redding, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally.

Two hundred forty soldiers from the 1st Battalion, 23rd Infantry Regiment, 7th Infantry Division based out of Joint Base Lewis McChord (JBLM) are deployed in support of wildland fire operations on the Little Giant fire. An Incident Management Organization (IMO) is assigned to support the military contingent.

Little Giant, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 5). CIMT is also managing the Sisi incident. Thirty miles northwest of Leavenworth, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, short-range spotting and single tree torching. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sisi, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Ten miles northwest of Stehekin, WA. Closed timber litter and timber. Active fire behavior with torching, flanking and backing. Energy infrastructure threatened. Trail closures in effect.

Three Queens, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 2). CIMT is also managing the King, Goat, Wonderland Complex and Grand Park 2 incidents. Six miles east of Snoqualmie Pass, WA. Timber and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with flanking, isolated torching and short-range spotting. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

King, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Snoqualmie Pass, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, isolated torching and short-range spotting. Communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Goat, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Fifteen miles north of Ronald, WA. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, isolated torching and short-range spotting. Communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wonderland Complex, Mount Rainier National Park, NPS. Twenty-one miles southeast of Buckley, WA. Timber and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with short-range spotting, isolated torching and flanking. Communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Grand Park 2, Mount Rainier National Park, NPS. Twenty-one miles southeast of Buckley, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and grass. Active fire behavior with short-range spotting, isolated torching and flanking. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

McCully, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 3). Twenty-two miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and grass. Extreme fire behavior with short crown runs, group torching and spotting. Numerous residences and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Paradise, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (SA Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Hagen incident. Eighteen miles east of Milton-Freewater, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hagen, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-six miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sinlahakin, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Transfer of command from CIMT (Cal Fire Team 5) to CIMT (SW Team 3) will occur tomorrow. One mile west of Tonasket, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Extreme fire behavior with uphill runs, torching and spotting. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Austin, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 4). CIMT is also managing the Narrows and Grasshopper incidents. Twenty-five miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with uphill runs, backing and single tree torching. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

The Narrows, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Fifteen miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Brush, grass and light slash. Minimal fire behavior with flanking, creeping and smoldering. Critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grasshopper, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Fourteen miles southwest of Dufur, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with isolated torching, backing and creeping. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wrights Spring, Fremont-Winema NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 7). Two miles west of Sprague River, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, isolated torching and smoldering. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Rowe Creek Complex (2 fires), Prineville District, BLM. Transfer of command from CIMT (ODF Team 2) to CIMT (CA Team 4) will occur today. Ten miles south of Fossil, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Luna, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Ten miles north of Newhalem, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, isolated torching and backing. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

High Lava, Gifford Pinchot NF, USFS. Eleven miles northwest of Stabler, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Big Grass, Vale District, BLM. Twenty-five miles southwest of Jordan Valley, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with running, flanking and wind-driven runs. Numerous structures threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

Kaiser Canyon, Colville Agency, BIA. One mile south of Nespelem, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Residences threatened.

Mitchell Springs, Vale District, BLM. Eight miles northwest of McDermitt, OR. Brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with creeping and smoldering.

Border 2, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Thirty-six miles northeast of Marblemount, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, flanking and isolated torching. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Electric, Mt. Baker-Snoqualmie NF, USFS. Seven miles north of Marblemount, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing and flanking. Road and trail closures in effect.

Ptarmigan, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Twenty miles northwest of Mazama, WA. Timber, heavy slash and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and torching. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Picture Rock, Lakeview District, BLM. Three miles north of Summer Lake, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Energy infrastructure threatened.

Rosenbaum, Fossil Unit, Oregon DOF. Ten miles northwest of Spray, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior.

Colwash, Yakama Agency, BIA. Five miles west of Mabton, WA. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Egypt, Malheur NF, USFS. Twelve miles north of Riley, OR. Timber and brush. No new information.

McConnell, Winnemucca District, BLM. Three miles east of Orovada, NV. Brush and grass. Extreme fire behavior with running and uphill runs. Residences threatened.

Wildhorse, Twin Falls District, BLM. Ten miles north of Kimama, ID. Grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, running and short-range spotting. Structures threatened.

Crooked, Boise NF, USFS. Fifteen miles east of Idaho City, ID. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with torching and flanking. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Calico, Humboldt-Toiyabe NF, USFS. Seventy-one miles north of Winnemucca, NV. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with running, wind-driven runs and torching. Residences threatened.

Oxley, Elko District, BLM. Five miles north of Wells, NV. Brush, grass and timber. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, creeping and smoldering. Residences and communication infrastructure threatened.

Blue Eagle, Carson City District, BLM. Twenty-eight miles northwest of Austin, NV. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with running, flanking and torching. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened.

Flint, Boise District, BLM. Forty-five miles southwest of Nampa, ID. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with running, flanking and wind-driven runs. Residences threatened.

Forleen, Elko District, BLM. Twenty-three miles north of Wells, NV. Brush, grass and dormant brush. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, smoldering and creeping. Structures threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Juniper Ridge, Winnemucca District, BLM. Ten miles northeast of Winnemucca, NV. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Critical infrastructure threatened. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Slough Canyon, Uintah and Ouray Agency, BIA. Forty-one miles east of Price, UT. Timber, brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, smoldering and creeping. Structures threatened.

Sombrero, Winnemucca District, BLM. Twenty-five miles northwest of Winnemucca, NV. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Kearny, White Pine County Fire Protection District. Thirty-seven miles north of Ely, NV. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with isolated torching, creeping and smoldering. Energy infrastructure threatened.

Black Canyon, Manti-La Sal NF, USFS. Twenty-nine miles southwest of Price, UT. Timber, brush and medium slash. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hawk, Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District. CIMT (GB Team 6). Five miles north of Reno, NV. Grass, timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering, creeping and isolated torching. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

* **Brushy Canyon**, Bear River Area, Utah DOF. Four miles north of Promontory, UT. Grass and chaparral. Extreme fire behavior with uphill runs, wind-driven runs and running.

* **Teddy Valley**, Southwest Area, Utah DOF. Eight miles southwest of Beaver, UT. Grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with wind-driven runs, spotting and torching.

Tom Creek, West Desert District, BLM. Ten miles south of Dugway, UT. Chaparral, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with torching and backing.

* **Dudley**, Idaho Panhandle NF, USFS. Five miles north of Wallace, ID. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and torching.

* **Roe 2**, Central Land Office, Montana DNRC. Twenty miles south of Dillon, MT. Brush and grass. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, running and flanking. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened.

Sand Creek, Beaverhead-Deerlodge NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 1). CIMT is also managing the Bobcat Lakes and Moose incidents. Five miles east of Wisdom, MT. Timber, brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Bobcat Lakes, Beaverhead-Deerlodge NF, USFS. Twelve miles east of Wisdom, MT. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Moose, Beaverhead-Deerlodge NF, USFS. Twenty-four miles southwest of Philipsburg, MT. Timber and heavy slash. Minimal fire behavior with flanking, backing and smoldering. Residences threatened. Road and trail closures in effect.

Nature Grove, Bitterroot NF, USFS. Fifteen miles southeast of Hamilton, MT. Timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, group torching and backing. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Deer Creek, Northwestern Land Office, Montana DNRC. Eighteen miles west of Marion, MT. Heavy slash and timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, flanking and single tree torching. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Silver, Idaho Panhandle NF, USFS. Eight miles northwest of Sandpoint, ID. Timber, brush and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with single tree torching, spotting and short crown runs. Area closures in effect.

Upper Smith, Idaho Panhandle NF, USFS. Six miles west of Porthill, ID. Timber, medium slash and brush. Active fire behavior with single tree torching, flanking and backing. Road and trail closures in effect.

Moose Mountain, Nez Perce-Clearwater NF, USFS. Twenty-seven miles northeast of Pierce, ID. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with backing, group torching and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Skillet, Flathead NF, USFS. Fifteen miles west of Olney, MT. Timber and heavy slash. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, smoldering and backing. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Porcupine, Idaho Panhandle NF, USFS. Seven miles north of Clark Fork, ID. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, isolated torching and creeping.

Camp Creek, Flathead NF, USFS. Twenty-five miles northeast of Seeley Lake, MT. Timber, brush and grass. Active fire behavior with group torching, flanking and backing. Structures threatened. Trail closures in effect.

Silvertip, Flathead NF, USFS. Thirty miles northeast of Condon, MT. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with backing, flanking and creeping. Structures threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

* **Cooper**, Bitterroot NF, USFS. Twenty-two miles southwest of Conner, ID. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with group torching, flanking and backing.

Cascade, Nez Perce-Clearwater NF, USFS. Nineteen miles east of Lowell, ID. Timber, brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Structures threatened. Trail closures in effect.

Grotto, Nez Perce-Clearwater NF, USFS. Twenty miles east of Lowell, ID. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, wind-driven runs and isolated torching. Trail closures in effect.

Three Links, Nez Perce-Clearwater NF, USFS. Twenty miles east of Lowell, ID. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing and flanking. Trail closures in effect.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Isolated to scattered mixed wet/dry thunderstorms are expected across portions of central/southern California, Nevada, Utah, Idaho, western Montana and Wyoming. Central and northern California will have increased risk of isolated dry lightning, elevating potential, while thunderstorms will be more numerous and wetter near the Sierra Crest. Low RH of 10–25% and gusty winds are expected across the Great Basin and into Wyoming and the West Slope, with wind gusts up to 45 mph possible in southern and western Wyoming. In the Southwest, isolated to scattered mixed wet/dry thunderstorms will favor Arizona and eastern/southern New Mexico. Across the eastern U.S., conditions will remain generally dry and seasonable for most areas, with scattered thunderstorms possible along the East Coast and across portions of the Southeast. Isolated to scattered thunderstorms are also expected across southern Texas and the Lower Mississippi Valley. Tropical Storm Dolly is expected to weaken while approaching the northeastern Caribbean, but associated moisture may increase showers and thunderstorms across Puerto Rico, but impacts remain uncertain.
