Two 15-member incident management teams and 212 fireline personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest and Great Basin geographic areas.

Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers from the 302nd Airlift Wing (Air Force Reserve, CO) and one from the 152nd Airlift Wing (NV Air National Guard), with respective support personnel, have been deployed to Klamath Falls, OR. Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel from the 146th Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard) have been deployed to Redding, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally.

Two hundred forty soldiers from the 1st Battalion, 23rd Infantry Regiment, 7th Infantry Division based out of Joint Base Lewis McChord (JBLM) are deployed in support of wildland fire operations on the Little Giant fire. An Incident Management Organization (IMO) is assigned to support the military contingent.

McConnell, Winnemucca District, BLM. Three miles east of Orovada, NV. Brush and grass. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs. Residences threatened.

Crooked, Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 3) mobilizing. Fifteen miles east of Idaho City, ID. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with torching, flanking and spotting. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Calico, Humboldt-Toiyabe NF, USFS. Twenty miles southeast of McDermitt, NV. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, isolated torching and smoldering. Residences threatened.

Blue Eagle, Carson City District, BLM. Twenty-eight miles northwest of Austin, NV. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with running, flanking and torching. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened.

Wildhorse, Twin Falls District, BLM. Ten miles north of Kimama, ID. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Structures threatened. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Brushy Canyon, Bear River Area, Utah DOF. Four miles north of Promontory, UT. Grass, chaparral and timber. Moderate fire behavior with single tree torching and running.

Slough Canyon, Uintah and Ouray Agency, BIA. Forty-one miles east of Price, UT. Timber, brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Structures threatened.

Flint, Boise District, BLM. Forty-five miles southwest of Nampa, ID. Grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and flanking. Residences threatened. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Forleen, Elko District, BLM. Twenty-three miles north of Wells, NV. Brush, grass and dormant brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Area and road closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Black Canyon, Manti-La Sal NF, USFS. Twenty-nine miles southwest of Price, UT. Timber, brush and medium slash. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Oxley, Elko District, BLM. Five miles north of Wells, NV. Brush, grass and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Hawk, Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District. CIMT (GB Team 6). Five miles north of Reno, NV. Grass, timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering, creeping and isolated torching. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Kearny, White Pine County Fire Protection District. Thirty-seven miles north of Ely, NV. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Energy infrastructure threatened.

Teddy Valley, Southwest Area, Utah DOF. Eight miles southwest of Beaver, UT. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Tom Creek, West Desert District, BLM. Ten miles south of Dugway, UT. Chaparral, grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with torching, creeping and backing.

Little Giant, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 5). CIMT is also managing the Sisi incident. Thirty miles northwest of Leavenworth, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Active fire behavior with group torching, short-range spotting and uphill runs. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sisi, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Ten miles northwest of Stehekin, WA. Closed timber litter and timber. Active fire behavior with torching, flanking and backing. Energy infrastructure threatened. Trail closures in effect.

Sinlahekin, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Transfer of command from CIMT (Cal Fire Team 5) to CIMT (SW Team 3) will occur today. One mile west of Tonasket, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Extreme fire behavior with uphill runs, torching and spotting. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

McCully, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 3). Twenty-two miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and group torching. Numerous residences and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Paradise, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (SA Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Hagen incident. Eighteen miles east of Milton-Freewater, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hagen, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-six miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Three Queens, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 2). CIMT is also managing the King, Goat, Wonderland Complex and Grand Park 2 incidents. Six miles east of Snoqualmie Pass, WA. Timber, brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, isolated torching and short-range spotting. Numerous residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

King, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Snoqualmie Pass, WA. Timber, brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, isolated torching and short-range spotting. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Goat, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Fifteen miles north of Ronald, WA. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, isolated torching and short-range spotting. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wonderland Complex, Mount Rainier National Park, NPS. Twenty-one miles southeast of Buckley, WA. Timber and closed timber litter. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, flanking and backing. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grand Park 2, Mount Rainier National Park, NPS. Twenty-one miles southeast of Buckley, WA. Timber and closed timber litter. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, flanking and backing. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Austin, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 4). CIMT is also managing the Narrows and Grasshopper incidents. Twenty-five miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with uphill runs, backing and single tree torching. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

The Narrows, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Fifteen miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Brush, grass and light slash. Minimal fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grasshopper, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Fourteen miles southwest of Dufur, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wrights Spring, Fremont-Winema NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 7). Two miles west of Sprague River, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Rowe Creek Complex (2 fires), Prineville District, BLM. CIMT (CA Team 4). Ten miles south of Fossil, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Breezy westerly winds of 15–25 mph, with gusts of 25–35 mph, are expected across much of the Intermountain West and northern Rockies. Gusts up to 45–50 mph are possible across parts of the northern Rockies, southern Nevada, Utah, northwest Colorado, and Wyoming. RH will generally range from 5–25%, with locally higher values across Nevada and northern Utah. RH of 10–20% will persist across inland California and the northern Great Basin, while 12–20% RH is expected from north Texas into Oklahoma. Isolated to scattered mixed wet/dry thunderstorms are expected across the central and eastern Great Basin into the central Rockies, particularly from eastern Nevada and southwest Utah into northwest Colorado and southern Wyoming. Scattered mixed wet/dry thunderstorms are also expected across the Southwest, primarily in Arizona and west of the Divide in New Mexico. Scattered thunderstorms, some potentially strong to severe, are forecast along and ahead of a cold front from the northern Plains into the Upper Midwest. Isolated to scattered thunderstorms are expected across Florida and the northern Gulf Coast, while most of the eastern U.S. remains dry with near- to slightly-below-normal temperatures.
