Two 15-member incident management teams and 212 fireline personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest and Great Basin geographic areas.

Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers from the 302nd Airlift Wing (Air Force Reserve, CO) and one from the 152nd Airlift Wing (NV Air National Guard), with respective support personnel, have been deployed to Santa Maria, CA. Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel from the 146th Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard) have been deployed to Redding, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally.

Two hundred forty soldiers from the 1st Battalion, 23rd Infantry Regiment, 7th Infantry Division based out of Joint Base Lewis McChord (JBLM) are deployed in support of wildland fire operations on the Little Giant fire. An Incident Management Organization (IMO) is assigned to support the military contingent.

Little Giant, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 5). CIMT is also managing the Sisi incident. Thirty miles northwest of Leavenworth, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sisi, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Ten miles northwest of Stehekin, WA. Closed timber litter and timber. Active fire behavior with torching, flanking and backing. Energy infrastructure threatened. Trail closures in effect.

Sinlahekin, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (SW Team 3). One mile west of Tonasket, WA. Grass, hardwood litter and timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, single tree torching and smoldering. Residences threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

McCully, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 3). Twenty-two miles northwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with flanking, group torching and spotting. Numerous residences and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Paradise, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (SA Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Hagen incident. Eighteen miles east of Milton-Freewater, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hagen, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-six miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Three Queens, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 2). CIMT is also managing the King, Goat, Grand Park 2 and Wonderland Complex incidents. Six miles east of Snoqualmie Pass, WA. Austin, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 4). CIMT is also managing the Grasshopper and the Narrows incidents. Twenty-five miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with uphill runs, backing and single tree torching. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grasshopper, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Fourteen miles southwest of Dufur, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Breezy westerly winds of 15–25 mph, with gusts of 25–45mph, are expected across parts of the northern and central Rockies. Winds across remaining parts of the Pacific Northwest and northern Great Basin are expected to be lighter than previous days, however locally dry and breezy winds continue across parts of the Sierra Front, southern Nevada and Utah, and much of Arizona amid RH of 5–25%. RH of 10–20% will persist across inland California and the northern Great Basin, while 12–25% RH and breezy southerly winds are expected from north Texas into Oklahoma, bringing high-risk significant fire potential to that area. Isolated to scattered mixed wet/dry thunderstorms are expected across eastern Nevada extending across Utah and southern Wyoming into the central Rockies, as well as Arizona and eastern New Mexico. Scattered thunderstorms, central and northern Plains. Isolated to scattered thunderstorms are expected across Florida and the northern Gulf Coast.
