Two 15-member incident management teams and 212 fireline personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest and Great Basin geographic areas.

Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers from the 302nd Airlift Wing (Air Force Reserve, CO) and one from the 152nd Airlift Wing (NV Air National Guard), with respective support personnel, have been deployed to Santa Maria, CA. Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel from the 146th Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard) have been deployed to Redding, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally.

Two hundred forty soldiers from the 1st Battalion, 23rd Infantry Regiment, 7th Infantry Division based out of Joint Base Lewis McChord (JBLM) are deployed in support of wildland fire operations on the Little Giant fire. An Incident Management Organization (IMO) is assigned to support the military contingent.

On August 30, a federal wildlife officer with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service was fatally injured while assisting with evacuations on the Railroad South Fire in Oklahoma. The firefighting community extends its condolences to the family and friends of the deceased.

McConnell, Winnemucca District, BLM. CIMT (GB Team 6). Three miles east of Orovada, NV. Brush and dormant brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and uphill runs. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Crooked, Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 3). Fifteen miles east of Idaho City, ID. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with torching, flanking and spotting. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Calico, Humboldt-Toiyabe NF, USFS. Twenty miles southeast of McDermitt, NV. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and isolated torching. Residences threatened.

Doublesprings, Salmon-Challis NF, USFS. Thirty-one miles northwest of Mackay, ID. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping.

Forleen, Elko District, BLM. Twenty-three miles north of Wells, NV. Brush, grass and dormant brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Black Canyon, Manti-La Sal NF, USFS. Twenty-nine miles southwest of Price, UT. Timber, brush and medium slash. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Little Giant, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 5). CIMT is also managing the Sisi incident. Thirty miles northwest of Leavenworth, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing and flanking. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sisi, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Ten miles northwest of Stehekin, WA. Closed timber litter and timber. Active fire behavior with torching, flanking and backing. Energy infrastructure threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

McCully, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 3). Twenty-two miles northwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with flanking, single tree torching and spotting. Numerous residences and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Paradise, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (SA Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Hagen incident. Eighteen miles east of Milton-Freewater, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hagen, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-six miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Austin, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 4). CIMT is also managing the Grasshopper and the Narrows incidents. Twenty-five miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with uphill runs, backing and single tree torching. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grasshopper, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Fourteen miles southwest of Dufur, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

The Narrows, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Fifteen miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Brush, grass and light slash. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sinlahekin, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (SW Team 3). One mile west of Tonasket, WA. Grass, hardwood litter and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Residences threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Three Queens, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 2). CIMT is also managing the King, Goat, Grand Park 2 and Wonderland Complex incidents. Six miles east of Snoqualmie Pass, WA. Timber, brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, creeping and isolated torching. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

King, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Snoqualmie Pass, WA. Timber, brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, creeping and isolated torching. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Goat, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Fifteen miles north of Ronald, WA. Timber, brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, creeping and isolated torching. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grand Park 2, Mount Rainier National Park, NPS. Twenty-one miles southeast of Buckley, WA. Timber and closed timber litter. Minimal fire behavior with isolated torching, creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wonderland Complex, Mount Rainier National Park, NPS. Twenty-one miles southeast of Buckley, WA. Timber and closed timber litter. Minimal fire behavior with isolated torching, creeping and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wrights Spring, Fremont-Winema NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 7). Two miles west of Sprague River, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Rowe Creek Complex (2 fires), Prineville District, BLM. CIMT (CA Team 4). Ten miles south of Fossil, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Luna, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Ten miles north of Newhalem, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Breezy southerly winds persist across much of the central and southern Plains, especially central/western Oklahoma and the Texas Panhandle where gusts up to 35 mph will create elevated to locally critical conditions amid very hot temperatures and low RH. Locally breezy winds and low RH generally 10-20% will also create elevated conditions across parts of the northern Great Basin into northeast California and southeastern Oregon. Strong westerly winds into the northern Plains with occasional gusts exceeding 40 mph across parts of eastern Montana into North Dakota. More robust monsoon moisture plume into Arizona and western New Mexico extending into much of the northern and eastern Great Basin and greater Four Corners and West Slope, resulting in scattered to numerous mixed wet/dry thunderstorms. Isolated to scattered mixed wet/dry thunderstorms east of the Divide in Colorado, southern Wyoming extending into the central Plains. Isolated to scattered thunderstorms develop over parts of central and south Texas, becoming more numerous along the Gulf Coast, Florida and southeast Atlantic coast.
