Cottonwood, Fishlake NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 5). Five miles east of Beaver, UT. Timber, brush and light slash. Active fire behavior with torching, short-range spotting and short crown runs. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Babylon, Manti-La Sal NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 2). Twenty-five miles southwest of Monticello, UT. Timber. Active fire behavior with torching, creeping and spotting. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wild Goose, Fishlake NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 7). Twelve miles northeast of Fillmore, UT. Timber, brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, short-range spotting and backing. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Snyder, Desert Rivers Fire and Aviation Management Unit, BLM. CIMT (RM Team 1). Thirteen miles west of Grand Junction, UT. Grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with wind-driven runs, creeping and single tree torching. Numerous residences and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grapevine, Ely District, BLM. Ten miles southeast of Caliente, NV. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area closures in effect.

Iron, Central Area, Utah DOF. CIMT (GB Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Cherry incident. One mile northwest of Eureka, UT. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Road closures in effect.

Cherry, West Desert District, BLM. Twenty-nine miles southwest of Santaquin, UT. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with creeping and single tree torching. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Parsnip Peak, Ely District, BLM. Eighteen miles northwest of Pioche, NV. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with group torching, backing and creeping. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Kinky Creek, Bridger-Teton NF, USFS. Thirty-four miles northwest of Cora, WY. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Residences threatened. Area closures in effect.

Horse Head, Desert Rivers Fire and Aviation Management Unit, BLM. Seven miles southwest of Eastland, UT. Dormant brush. Minimal fire behavior with isolated torching. Residences threatened. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Dry Canyon, Ely District, BLM. Fourteen miles east of Pioche, NV. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Kane Springs, Ely District, BLM. Seventeen miles southwest of Caliente, NV. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Railroad infrastructure threatened.

Aspen Acres, Custer County. CIMT (AK Team 1). Ten miles northwest of Rye, CO. Timber and medium slash. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, crowning and spotting. Numerous residences threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Ferris, San Juan NF, USFS. Seven miles east of Cahone, CO. Includes the acreage from the previously reported Doe Canyon fire. Timber, brush and grass. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, flanking and short-range spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Willow, Pike and San Isabel NF, USFS. CIMT (SW Team 4). Six miles west of Leadville, CO. Brush, closed timber litter and timber. Active fire behavior with short crown runs, group torching and short-range spotting. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

* **Log Road**, Nebraska Forest Service. Twelve miles northwest of Crawford, NE. Timber, grass and light slash. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, torching and spotting. Structures threatened.

* **Sheep Head**, Huerfano County. Twenty-two miles northwest of Walsenburg, CO. Brush, timber and grass. Moderate fire behavior with short crown runs, isolated torching and creeping. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Southwest winds 12-25 mph with gusts 25-45 mph amid RH of 3-15% will develop across the Greater Four Corners into the central High Plains today creating widespread elevated to critical conditions. The strongest winds are likely in the Four Corners to the southern Front Range of Colorado. Isolated dry thunderstorms will also develop from central and eastern New Mexico into the Front Range and central High Plains this afternoon with several new ignitions likely. Farther north and west, cooler temperatures will continue for California into the northwestern U.S., and scattered showers and thunderstorms will develop in the northern Great Basin to northern Rockies. Well above normal temperatures are expected in the Great Lakes, but relative humidity will remain elevated and green-up will help mitigate. Isolated to scattered showers and thunderstorms will develop from the central Plains into the Great Lakes and Northeast, as well, with scattered thunderstorms along the northern Gulf Coast into Florida. Cool and showery conditions are expected across much of Alaska today, while moderate trade winds and scattered showers are expected in Hawai'i.
