E Evans Creek Rd, Medford Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (ODF Team 1). Fourteen miles northeast of Rogue River, OR. Brush, closed timber litter and timber. Extreme fire behavior with spotting, short crown runs and group torching. Numerous residences and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Salmon, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 12). CIMT is also managing the Olive Butte incident. Thirty-four miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and single tree torching. Numerous residences and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Olive Butte, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. Thirty-four miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Numerous residences and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Anthony, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 3). Thirty-four miles north of Baker City, OR. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Lower Dry Creek Mutual Aid, Pendleton Unit, Oregon DOF. Twenty-two miles northeast of Pendleton, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

* **Crosswhite**, Prineville District, BLM. Six miles west of Twickenham, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with running, flanking and backing. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened.

* **Twickenham**, Prineville District, BLM. Seven miles southwest of Service Creek, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with running, torching and flanking. Structures threatened.

* **Porcupine Ridge**, Prineville District, BLM. Twenty-five miles west of Condon, OR. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with running, isolated torching and backing. Residences threatened.

* **Cove Creek**, Prineville District, BLM. Seven miles northeast of Clarno, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with crowning and group torching. Structures threatened.

* **Brewer**, Prineville Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (ODF Team 2) mobilizing. Thirteen miles east of Madras, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with torching, running and backing.

* **Hopkin**, Prineville District, BLM. Fifteen miles north of Condon, OR. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with running and backing. Residences threatened.

* **Lyons Ferry**, Washington State Fire Marshal's Office. Sixteen miles east of Kahlotus, WA. Grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, uphill runs and running. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

* **Kaiser Canyon**, Colville Agency, BIA. Five miles south of Nespelem, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, wind-driven runs and spotting. Numerous residences threatened. Road closures in effect.

* **Royal Lake**, Mid Columbia NWR, FWS. Eight miles northwest of Othello, WA. Grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with running, spotting and torching.

* **Riddle**, Burns District, BLM. Twelve miles east of Diamond, OR. Grass and timber. Moderate fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Structures threatened.

* **Camel Hump**, Prineville District, BLM. Five miles southwest of Service Creek, OR. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with isolated torching, running and backing.

* **Wilcox**, Prineville District, BLM. Nine miles northeast of Shaniko, OR. Grass. Active fire behavior with running, flanking and backing.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Dry conditions will return to the West Coast on Friday as high pressure shifts east, confining monsoonal moisture to the eastern Great Basin, Southwest, and Colorado. Those areas will see scattered afternoon showers and a mix of wet and dry thunderstorms with gusty outflow winds. California and much of the Pacific Northwest will remain hot and dry, while a dry air mass and gusty westerly winds (25–35 mph) spread across the Pacific Northwest and northern California behind an upper-level trough.

East of the ridge, scattered showers and thunderstorms are expected across the Upper Mississippi Valley and Upper Great Lakes, with localized heavy rainfall possible along a cold front. Gusty northwesterly winds will develop behind the front. Wildfire smoke from Minnesota and Canada will continue affecting the Great Lakes and Northeast, reducing temperatures and air quality. Showers are also expected across the Mid-Atlantic and parts of Florida, while Texas begins to dry out except for hot, dry conditions across Deep South Texas.
