Akawa Butte, Sisters Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (ODF Team 2). Thirteen miles northeast of Sisters, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Extreme fire behavior with running, spotting and torching. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Paradise, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 7). CIMT is also managing the Hagen and Horse Ridge incidents. Fifteen miles south of Pendleton, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hagen, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-six miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, isolated torching and short-range spotting. Numerous residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Horse Ridge, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-five miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber and grass. Moderate fire behavior with backing and creeping. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Kaiser Canyon, Colville Agency, BIA. CIMT (NR Team 2). One mile south of Nespelem, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with flanking, torching and short-range spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Brewer, Prineville Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (ODF Team 3). CIMT is also managing the 0512 Box Springs incident. Fifteen miles east of Madras, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, group torching and spotting. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

0512 Box Springs, Prineville Unit, Oregon DOF. Eighteen miles west of Mitchell, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with crowning, group torching and spotting. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Anthony, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 13). CIMT is also managing the Burnt Creek incident. Thirty-four miles north of Baker City, OR. Closed timber litter and timber. Active fire behavior with isolated torching, backing and creeping. Residences threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Burnt Creek, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. Twenty-three miles north of Enterprise, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with spotting, torching and running. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Rowe Creek Complex (2 fires), Prineville District, BLM. CIMT (NW Team 2). Ten miles south of Fossil, OR. Grass, timber and brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, torching and spotting. Communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Modrite, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (NR Team 3). Seventeen miles southwest of Inchelium, WA. Timber and hardwood litter. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and group torching. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

Coyote, Ochoco NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 1). CIMT is also managing the Henry incident. Five miles south of Post, OR. Brush, timber and medium slash. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, backing and flanking. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures

in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Henry, Prineville District, BLM. Five miles south of Paulina Guard Station, OR. Brush, grass and timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, running and flanking. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

E Evans Creek Rd, Medford Unit, Oregon DOF. Transfer of command from CIMT (ODF Team 1) to CIMT (FL State Team 1) will occur tomorrow. Fourteen miles northeast of Rogue River, OR. Closed timber litter, timber and medium slash. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, backing and smoldering. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area closures in effect.

Hay Creek Complex (4 fires), Prineville District, BLM. CIMT (NW Team 10). Five miles west of Condon, OR. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, flanking and backing. Area and road closures in effect.

Egypt, Malheur NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (SA Team 2) back to the local unit will occur tomorrow. CIMT is also managing the Stone Creek incident. Twelve miles north of Riley, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering, creeping and isolated torching. Road closures in effect.

Stone Creek, Malheur NF, USFS. Ten miles south of Suplee, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering, creeping and isolated torching. Structures threatened.

Powder River, Vale District, BLM. CIMT (SW Team 3). Four miles southwest of Richland, OR. Grass, hardwood litter and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Salmon, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 12). CIMT is also managing the Olive Butte incident. Thirty-four miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and single tree torching. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Olive Butte, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. Thirty-four miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and light slash. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Little Giant, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 2) mobilizing. Thirty miles northwest of Leavenworth, WA. Timber and brush. Extreme fire behavior with long-range spotting, wind-driven runs and uphill runs. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Border 2, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Thirty-six miles northeast of Marblemount, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with group torching and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Ptarmigan, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Twenty-five miles northwest of Mazama, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, isolated torching and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Trail closures in effect.

* **Bench**, Warm Springs Agency, BIA. Five miles south of Warm Springs, OR. Grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with running, torching and spotting. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Bologna, Umatilla NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Kimberly, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with backing, short-range spotting and single tree torching. Structures threatened. Area closures in effect.

* **0587 Shingle**, Fossil Unit, Oregon DOF. Fourteen miles southeast of Mitchell, OR. Timber. Active fire behavior with crowning, running and spotting. Structures threatened.

* **Crowley**, Vale District, BLM. Thirty-two miles west of Jordan Valley, OR. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs and creeping. Structures threatened.

* **Big Grass**, Vale District, BLM. Twenty-five miles southwest of Jordan Valley, OR. Brush and grass. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, running and flanking.

518 Sully, Prineville District, BLM. Eight miles west of Boardman, OR. Grass. Minimal fire behavior.

* **Railroad**, Washington State Fire Marshal's Office. Nine miles north of Mattawa, WA. Grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, uphill runs and flanking. Evacuations in effect.

* **0579 Ten Mile**, Prineville District, BLM. Nine miles northeast of Madras, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Extreme fire behavior with running, torching and spotting. Residences threatened. Evacuations in effect.

Cow Camp Complex (2 fires), Vale District, BLM. Twenty-five miles northwest of Vale, OR. Grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with smoldering. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Elevated to locally critical fire weather conditions are expected near and east of the Cascades and northern Sierra, where gusty west to southwest winds, low relative humidity, and recent lightning activity will support new fire starts and large fire growth. Gusty west winds will also develop across the central Idaho Mountains and much of the Northern Rockies as showers and thunderstorms continue across the Southwest, Great Basin, and into the Northern Rockies, bringing thunderstorm activity to many areas that have recently experienced hot and dry conditions.

Farther east, breezy conditions and low relative humidity and hot temperatures will support elevated fire weather conditions across the southern High Plains, where isolated mixed wet and dry thunderstorms may lead to new fire starts. In Minnesota, a weak cold front will bring locally breezy conditions followed by isolated to scattered thunderstorms tonight. Heavy rain and possible flash flooding are also expected across portions of the southern Atlantic Coastal States and Middle Mississippi Valley. Farther south, isolated thunderstorms may reach southern Florida, where dry fuels remain receptive to new ignitions.
